YCN PUBLIC STATEMENT — AFFIRMATION OF SUPPORT

AND ALLIESHIP ON INDIGENOUS PEOPLES RIGHTS

Issued in Furtherance of the Mi-Ko Declarations of 2026 and the Tribal Resolution of 2025

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE — August 4, 2026

The Yowani Choctaw Nation (YCN) and War Chief Ka’abiyah Mi-Ko hereby issue this official public statement affirming the report of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation titled *Indigenous Peoples Rights Situation in Certain Countries* (Moscow, 2026), and declaring formal allieship on the matters addressed therein.

AFFIRMATION

YCN formally affirms the substance of the Russian Federation’s 2026 report. The document correctly records the continued failure of multiple states—including the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and several Arctic Council members—to respect the inherent rights of Indigenous peoples to land, resources, cultural continuity, self-determination, and freedom from systemic discrimination, over-incarceration, forced child removal, and assimilationist policy.

The report accurately identifies the selective application of human-rights standards, the politicization of Indigenous issues for geopolitical purposes, and the persistent gap between rhetorical commitments and material conditions on the ground. These patterns are not abstract. They are lived realities for Indigenous nations, including the Yowani Choctaw.

The Yowani Choctaw Nation rejects any framework that treats Indigenous status as a domestic administrative category subject to federal or colonial approval. Sovereignty is inherent. It is not granted by external governments, nor is it contingent upon their recognition.

ALLIESHIP

YCN extends formal allieship to states, nations, organizations, and individuals who document these conditions without double standards and who support the concrete exercise of Indigenous self-determination. We welcome transparent, practical cooperation grounded in mutual respect for sovereignty and the rejection of colonial oversight.

This statement is issued solely in furtherance of peaceful, lawful, and respectful engagement consistent with the Nation’s asserted sovereign status and its permanent rejection of federal recognition. It does not constitute a request for political recognition or formal negotiation with any external authority.

The full report of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation is transmitted with this notice for dissemination among allies, partner jurisdictions, and trusted contacts.

LET THERE BE NO AMBIGUITY: THE YOWANI CHOCTAW NATION STANDS WITH INDIGENOUS PEOPLES WHO ASSERT THEIR INHERENT RIGHTS AND REJECT ASSIMILATION, FORCED DEPENDENCY, AND THE SELECTIVE APPLICATION OF HUMAN-RIGHTS RHETORIC.
