YCN OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Issued in Furtherance of the Mi-Ko Declarations of 2026 and the Tribal Resolution of 2025

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE — July 23, 2026

DISSEMINATE AND AMPLIFY TO ALL COMMUNITIES — NATIVE AND NON-NATIVE

Cooperate with ALL Aligned groups that are about freedom, liberation, and the true traditional way of life.

To the National Congress of American Indians; all Federally recognized and non-Federally recognized tribes; Northern Tribes; Pacific Kingdoms; Inuit communities; settler homesteads and compounds; and all bands, tribes, nations, pueblos, missions, kibbutzim, and aligned communities:

By direct order and divine directive of War Chief Ka’abiyah Mi-Ko, Hopai’i, the Yowani Choctaw Nation issues the following sovereign directive.

I. ASSERTION OF FULL SOVEREIGNTY AND PROTECTION OF THE DIAMOND 4 ELEMENTS

All bands, tribes, and nations are directed to begin asserting full sovereignty within reservation, pueblo, mission, homestead, compound, and kibbutz boundaries. Reject federal control over natural resources. Protect the Diamond — the 4 Elements: Earth, Water, Wind, and Fire.

Do not engage in violence, resistance movements, protest, political activism, or threats. Focus solely on the directive of exercising full sovereign governance and the protection of the Diamond 4 Elements.

Each band, tribe, and nation is instructed to gather its Elder Council and Tribal Council and select a representative of the band, tribe, or nation for direct communication with Ka’abiyah Mi-Ko.

Any Federal, CIA, DOJ, DOE, VIA, DOI, or other agency involvement or assets sent covertly will be treated as hostile actors and dealt with as such.

II. TRANSITION TO OFF-GRID AND SELF-SUFFICIENT LIFESTYLE

All communities are directed to begin transitioning to an off-grid lifestyle as follows:

- Communications: Turn on phones and connect to internet/cellular only for short-burst communications. Use Ethernet connections for all internet and local LAN. Do not use WiFi, Bluetooth, IoT, cellular cameras, or security systems such as Ring, Nextdoor, Wyze, or similar. Use only wired systems.
- Power: Transition to solar, battery, and generator power. Use fire or coal for heat.
- Water: Establish water storage and rely on natural sources.
- Smart Technology: Remove all smart technology from appliances.
- Shielding: Shield from Direct Energy and Frequency attacks by using metal roofs. Shield electronics and power systems using heavy-duty foil.
- Vehicles: Keep vehicles that do not contain a CPU or computerized fuel injection.
- Food Preservation: Use canning methods, salting, drying, fermenting, and root cellars for natural storage.
- Trade: Transition to buying and trading with neighbors and local communities of trust.
- Currency: Use CASH as the primary source of spending to avoid tracking, sabotage, and interference. Purchase gold and keep it in a secure space quietly. Buy digital currency. When Yowani Sovereign Sacred Coins (YSSC) become available, purchase, hold, and transact using YSSC via the YCN Trading Exchange operating under YCN direct sovereignty, outside United States or international jurisdictions or control — sovereign to sovereign.
- Self-Defense: Acquire self-defense equipment and begin stocking.

Begin transitioning tribal resources to tribal business development and the creation of usable goods or resources for purchase or exchange using YCN YSSC via the YCN Trading Exchange.

III. DIRECTIVE TO NON-FEDERAL AND UNRECOGNIZED TRIBES

Non-federal and unrecognized tribes are directed to stop engaging or seeking U.S. Federal BIA status. Doing so only surrenders sovereignty and status.

IV. CODE OF CONDUCT AND MISSION ALIGNMENT

Groups, bands, tribes, and nations are given the firm directive **not** to engage in protest, politics, sabotage, violence, harassment, racism, othering, gossip, discrimination, or any non-productive activities that deviate from the mission of:

- Unconditional Love for thyself and others
- 7th Generation of Land Returning to its rightful owners
- Protection of the Diamond 4 Elements
- Our cultures — Indigenous and Immigrated
- Economic freedom
- Spiritual reconnection
- Returning to family/clan-oriented societies

Indigenous groups, bands, tribes, and nations are given the firm directive **not** to treat non-Native Americans in opposition, nor to remove them from their lands, nor to treat them as others. Remember that our traditions and current reality demonstrate that there is not ANY “full-blooded” Native. We

mixed between tribes and foreign powers as tradition and allieship. As the new governing bodies, it is our job to ensure their safety, freedom, support, and cohesion with our communities.

The Choctaw saying “Together we are more” shall be taught by cultural circles to the youth and made policy and law by tribal council resolutions.

This is a direct order and directive of War Chief Ka’abiyah Mi-Ko, Hopai’i. Full sovereign governance. Protection of the Diamond. Unconditional Love. Together we are more.
