Yowani Choctaw Nation Mission Statement

The Yowani Choctaw Nation exists to reclaim, restore, and exercise full sovereignty in entirety over our ancestral lands, our laws, our economy, our security, our natural resources, our culture, our people, our languages, and our spiritual and energetic worlds—ensuring the survival and flourishing of Yowani Choctaw identity for all generations to come.

We commit ourselves to:

- **Reclaiming sovereignty in its entirety** — land, legal authority, trade, security, natural resources, culture, our people, our languages, and our spiritual/energetic sovereignty.
- **Protecting and expanding our territorial boundaries**, self-governing institutions, and independent decision-making power.
- **Securing our lands through legal, economic, and defensive means** while preserving their sacred and economic value.
- **Exercising full legal sovereignty** by creating and enforcing our own codes, courts, and dispute-resolution systems.
- **Building self-sufficient trade networks** grounded in reciprocity and our own values.
- **Defending our communities** with strength, wisdom, and tradition.
- **Managing our natural resources**—water, soil, forests, wildlife, minerals—as stewards of the land for future generations.
- **Revitalizing and transmitting our rich culture, languages, and spiritual practices** so that every Yowani Choctaw lives them fully.
- **Strengthening our people** through unity, education, health, and connection to our ancestral ways.
- **Reclaiming our spiritual and energetic sovereignty** so that our traditions, ceremonies, and life-force remain protected and active.
- **Upholding our long-standing peace treaties** and harmonious relations with other Native American clans, bands, tribes, and nations.
- **Holding the United States of America accountable** for land stolen throughout its inception and annexation of our lands in our Texas District.
- **Negotiating a permanent peace treaty with the United States** based on peace, prosperity, and partnership.

This mission is the heartbeat of the Yowani Choctaw Nation: to live as a sovereign nation—undivided, unapologetic, and unbreakable—while honoring the living legacy of our ancestors and the sacred trust given to us by the Creator.
