YCN OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Issued in Furtherance of the Mi-Ko Declarations of 2026 and the Tribal Resolution of 2025

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE — August 3, 2026

The Yowani Choctaw Nation (YCN) and War Chief Ka'abiyah Mi-Ko hereby issue this official public statement rejecting, in the strongest terms, any and all forms of unauthorized atmospheric modification, weather intervention, or environmental manipulation conducted over Condado, Ocean Park Beach, or any other area of Puerto Rico under any pretense of operational necessity, support, or convenience directed at the War Chief or the Nation.

For more than two consecutive weeks, continuous aerial dispersal of chemical and metallic compounds has been conducted with the observable purpose of suppressing natural rainfall in order to force prolonged artificial “sunny” conditions. This unauthorized activity constitutes a direct assault on the sovereignty of the Yowani Choctaw Nation and a desecration of the Diamond Element—Water, Wind, Earth, and Fire—which the Nation holds as sacred and indivisible.

The same operation culturally appropriates the Choctaw Hashtulli signal, an authentic traditional indicator employed by the War Chief for the identification of genuine, organic meetings, and redirects it toward staged encounters with external operational assets. Such appropriation is a profound violation of living tradition and an instrument of deception. YCN will never accept or legitimize the misuse of sacred signals for external agendas.

ON THE HARM TO LAND, SEA, AND SACRED BALANCE

Unauthorized weather modification produces cascading atmospheric disturbances. Historical precedent includes the extreme flooding events in Dubai following large-scale interventions. The present campaign has already induced localized drought, accelerated beach erosion, altered seasonal foliage patterns, and inflicted harm upon the marine ecosystem, including critical habitat of the Leatherback sea turtle and other protected life. These impacts are unacceptable and irreversible without immediate cessation and remediation.

Sovereignty is not advanced by back-channel environmental control, staged optics, or the sacrifice of natural systems for the convenience of external operations. True support requires transparent, direct government-to-government engagement that respects the Nation's laws, council authority, and sacred traditions.

CONDITIONS AND REJECTION OF COMPROMISE

YCN demands immediate and permanent cessation of all unauthorized atmospheric spraying and chemical/metal compound dispersal. The Nation further demands full accounting of the operational chain of command, the composition of dispersed materials, and the restoration of natural rainfall cycles and coastal integrity.

No deniable covers. No staged transfers. No covert tradecraft framed as support. No external control over the atmosphere, the land, or the sacred signals of the Nation. Full and permanent rejection of any such scheme.

The Yowani Choctaw Nation will not be used as a vehicle for external agendas, nor will its leadership, land, or traditions be subjected to compromised operations that undermine privacy, safety, liberty, ecological balance, and sovereign self-determination.

LET THERE BE NO MISTAKE: YCN REJECTS ALL UNAUTHORIZED WEATHER MODIFICATION, ALL CULTURAL APPROPRIATION OF HASHTULLI AND SACRED SIGNALS, AND ALL ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS TARGETING THE WAR CHIEF OR THE NATION.

YCN remains committed solely to peaceful, lawful, and respectful government-to-government dialogue consistent with the Nation's asserted sovereign status and its permanent rejection of federal recognition. This position will not change.
