YCN OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Issued in Furtherance of the Mi-Ko Declarations of 2026 and the Tribal Resolution of 2025

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE — July 26, 2026

The Yowani Choctaw Nation (YCN) and War Chief Ka’abiyah Mi-Ko hereby issue this official public statement rejecting, in the strongest terms, any and all forms of deniable or covert “support” that involve the transfer, loan, or placement of Department of Defense, Federal, Oregon State, or Territory resources, assets, and equipment under any pretense of assistance to the Yowani Choctaw Nation.

This includes, without limitation, municipal and tourist police vehicles, public transport assets, investments directed toward VA facilities, and any other equipment or infrastructure offered or staged through deniable channels. YCN will never accept such transfers. Acceptance of resources delivered by deniable means, rather than through direct government-to-government funding that enables the Tribe to purchase and control assets internally, would constitute a direct assault on the sovereignty of the Yowani Choctaw Nation.

Sovereignty is not advanced by back-channel deliveries, staged optics, or assets that remain under external control or influence. True support requires transparent, direct funding to the Nation so that the Nation itself may procure, own, and operate its own equipment under its own laws and council authority.

ON THE DEFIANT 40 MARITIME SECURITY ASSETS

The War Chief previously presented plans for Defiant 40 vessels for maritime security and counter-trafficking operations. A formal purchase order was passed by the Tribal Council. Notwithstanding this legitimate internal process, the agency and Department of Defense acquired at least two such vessels and have proceeded to parade them in the presence of the War Chief.

This conduct occurs while the same apparatus engages in an absurd and unauthorized “Bachelor Puerto Rico” effort—attempting to match the War Chief with a mate—despite the War Chief already having a partner and a high-level tribal security team. The War Chief is not available for external matchmaking, nor is he a participant in any such compromised social engineering. The absurdity of these parallel actions is incomprehensible.

The expenditure of American taxpayer resources on these activities is fraudulent, wasteful, and abusive. Taxpayers work diligently and deserve accountability. The War Chief is not participating in, consenting to, or being complicit in this compromised operation in any form.

CONDITIONS AND REJECTION OF COMPROMISE

The War Chief continues to be denied basic necessities: adequate food, proper medical and dental care, suitable accommodations, and access to his team and partner. These denials stand in stark contrast to the resources being expended on deniable assets and unauthorized social operations.

YCN demands direct government-to-government engagement only. No deniable covers. No staged transfers. No covert tradecraft framed as support. No external control over assets intended for the Nation. Full and permanent rejection of any such scheme.

The Yowani Choctaw Nation will not be used as a vehicle for external agendas, nor will its leadership be subjected to compromised operations that undermine privacy, safety, liberty, and sovereign self-determination.

LET THERE BE NO MISTAKE: YCN REJECTS ALL DENIABLE COVERT SUPPORT AND ALL ASSOCIATED ASSET TRANSFERS.

YCN remains committed solely to peaceful, lawful, and respectful government-to-government dialogue consistent with the Nation’s asserted sovereign status and its permanent rejection of federal recognition. This position will not change.
