



Earth Worm Tea Maker-300

Operating Instructions

Thank you for your purchase of Long Worm Ag Products Earthworm Tea Maker-300.

From years of research and development, Long Worm Ag Products has made it easy for you to produce the best premium earthworm castings tea at your home or business.

Listed below are 10 simple steps to make a single 250-gallon batch of earthworm tea.

Overview

- 1) Attach the 1,000-gallon de-chlorinator to your city or well water supply.
- 2) Fill the tea maker-300 with 250 gallons of filtered water.
- 3) Plug in the Ultra 9000 air blower and aerate the water for 12 hours to bring the oxygen levels up to 6 ppm and also vaporize off any organics that may be in your water supply. You can shut off the blower for up to 3 hours, but should remain on for 24 hours a day to keep oxygen levels above 6 ppm and to keep the microbiology alive, fresh and activated.
- 4) Open the Ultra 9000 blower main valve all the way open.
- 5) Attach the supplied the worm castings 200-micron tea bags female cam-lock to the inside of the tea makers Ultra 9000 blowers' diffusers male camlock. Zip tie closed the female cam-lock eye rings.
- 6) Pour into the 250 gallons of the tea maker-300,'s filtered water, 2-bottles of tea maker dry ingredient #1 and 2-bottles of the tea maker liquid ingredients #2 and aerate for an additional 12 hours.
- 7) Make sure the water spicket worm tea product supply valve is closed.
- 8) Open the tea makers 2" main outlet bottom valve.
- 9) Plug in the up Power-Flow 5830 on demand pump.
- 10) Connect the water spicket to your external equipment or fill up a bucket container by opening the spicket to dispense the activated earthworm tea.

****After you have emptied the tea maker-300, pressure wash the tea maker tank, hoses and contact your Long Worm Ag Products distributor for a new tea maker-300 castings tea bag and feed bottles. (Bring back your old tea bag and extractor for a \$20 credit towards your next tea and feed purchase.)

Operating Instructions

- 1) Attach the 1,000-gallon de-chlorinator to your city or well water supply.



- 2) Fill the tea maker-300 with 250 gallons of filtered water.



- 3) Plug in the Ultra 9000 air blower and aerate the water for 12 hours to bring the oxygen levels up to 6 ppm and also to vaporize off any organics that may be in your water supply. You can shut off the air blower for up to 3 hours, but should normally remain on for 24 hours a day to keep oxygen levels above 6 ppm and to keep the microbiology alive, fresh and activated.

4) Open the Ultra 9000 blower main valve all the way open.



5) While one hand is holding open the female cam-lock eye clamps (pic#1), (Pic #2) attach the worm castings 200-micron tea bags female cam-lock to the inside of the tea makers Ultra 9000 blowers' diffusers male camlock and close the cam-lock clamps with the other hand. (Pic #3) Zip tie closed the female cam-lock eye rings.

- 6) Pour into the 250 gallons of the tea maker-300,'s filtered water, 2-bottles of tea maker dry ingredient #1 and 2-bottles of the tea maker liquid ingredients #2 and aerate for an additional 12 hours.



- 7) Make sure the drip free water spicket worm tea product supply valve is closed.



- 11) Open the tea makers 2" main outlet bottom valve.

8) Plug in the Power-Flow 5830 on demand pump.



12) Connect the water spicket to your external equipment or fill up a bucket container by opening the spicket to dispense the activated earthworm tea.



*****After you have emptied the tea maker-300, pressure wash the tea maker tank, hoses and contact your Long Worm Ag Products distributor for a new tea maker-300 castings tea bag and feed bottles. (Bring back your old tea bag and extractor for a \$20 credit towards your next tea and feed purchase.)
