

Emily Moyer Hadley

GREENVILLE - Emily Moyer Hadley, formerly of Greenville, died on February 5, 2003 at the age of 100 in Maryville, Tennessee, where she had resided for the past nine years.

Mrs. Hadley was born in Greenville and graduated from Greenville High School in 1919 and from Salem College, Winston-Salem, NC in 1924. She taught second grade at Third Street School from 1940-1949, and from 1949-1968 she traveled a territory of 13 eastern North Carolina counties as a North Carolina Department of Labor inspector.

She had been a member of Jarvis Memorial United Methodist Church since 1912. In 1926 she was an organizing member of the Greenville Patriots Chapter of the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She was also an organizing member of the Greenville Service League and the German Club and a charter member of the Pitt County Historical Society. Along with four other family members, Mrs. Hadley was a donor of 17 acres of the Moyer Plantation to the County for the construction of Pitt Memorial Hospital on West Fifth Street, now the County Office Building.

She is survived by her daughter, Martha Hadley Callaway, and son-in-law, Dr. Henry Abbott Callaway, Jr. of Maryville, Tennessee; four grandsons, Henry Abbott Callaway III of Mobile, AL, Dr. Thomas Howard Callaway of Atlanta, GA, Dr. George Hadley Callaway of Raleigh and Edward Moyer Callaway of Nashville, TN; nine great-grandchildren, Miller and Harrison Callaway of Mobile, Patton and Isabel Callaway of Atlanta, Darden, Sherwood and Lee Callaway of Raleigh, and Caleb and Elizabeth Callaway of Nashville. Other survivors include three nephews, Dr. Edward S. Williams, Jr. of Durham, Joseph S. Moyer of Atlanta, GA and William T. Moyer of Washington D.C.

A memorial service will be held Saturday afternoon at 4:00 at Jarvis Memorial United Methodist Church. The family will receive friends immediately following the service.

Private burial will be at Cherry Hill Cemetery.
