**ENTRIES:** Make checks payable to **Les Bois Dressage, LLC** and send to ***SECRETARY*** listed above. Use [Entry Form B](#) available at [www.idahodressageandeventing.org](http://www.idahodressageandeventing.org). **ODS members please put your ODS# under "local" box.** All entries must be **postmarked** by the closing date, any late entries will be accepted at the discretion of management and put on a waiting list. Classes filled on a first-come first-serve basis and the show fills fast. No assurances will be made until the schedule is printed. **\*All copies of membership cards must be included. Go to [eqverification.org](http://eqverification.org) to find and print them all in one place!** Except for USEF/USDF Championship classes and for FEI Pony Riders, FEI Junior, FEI Young Rider and FEI Para-Equestrian Freestyles, in order to enter a freestyle class at any level, **a horse/rider combination must have received a minimum score of 63% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level** at a Federation Licensed or FEI recognized Dressage Competition or "open" Dressage class (i.e. open to all breeds) at a Federation Licensed Competition held prior to the competition where the horse/rider combination is entered to ride a freestyle class. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility or copy of the USDF score verification, must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class.

If riding in Official 2019 NAYC and USEF Qualifying classes and qualifying for Great American/USDF Championships pay the additional \$15 qualifying fee when appropriate. Measurement Card required & must be submitted with entry for FEI Pony rider tests. Please specify Open (O), Adult Amateur (AA), Jr. Young Rider (Jr/YR) on entry form. If not specified, you will be placed in the Open division. FEI Pony for riders 12-16. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, split classes, change arenas, or limit the number of rides per rider to facilitate the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. Freestyle music check will be conducted **each day** BEFORE the official show start time.

**VACCINATIONS NOTICE:** Exhibitors are reminded of USEF's new vaccination policy, effective 12/1/15; see GR845 for details. Download the form from:

<https://www.usef.org/documents/membership/EquineVaccinationRecord.pdf> and bring the completed form, signed by your veterinarian, with you to the competition. If you select an alternative option under the rules, please bring required documentation. Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload, and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. ***No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the vaccination documentation is missing or incomplete.***

**SCRATCHES/REFUNDS:** Please be aware of opening and closing dates. Refunds will be all fees minus \$50 cancellation fee prior to closing date. No refunds after closing date or at discretion of management.

**TIMES:** The preferred method of notification for all entries is email, so please include a clearly readable email address with entry. Ride times will also be posted at the show in a conspicuous place by 12pm the day before and available on Fox Village website. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

**STABLING VERY LIMITED:** Please contact Nadine Schwartsman to arrange & pay separately from show entry. [nadine.schwartsman@gmail.com](mailto:nadine.schwartsman@gmail.com) PACKAGE PRICE of \$150 for the show weekend (Friday thru Sunday, horse stall. 12x12 stalls—both permanent and temporary. Depends on availability. NO tack stalls available), If arriving before Friday additional nights at \$40, 2 bags of initial bedding provided. Feed and bedding (\$10/bag) available for purchase. Les Bois Dressage will do the final cleaning upon departure. No Coggins required for Idaho horses (out of State please include Coggins), but see Vaccinations Notice above.

**ARENAS:** All tests will be ridden in a 20x60 meter outdoor dressage arena with hoofgrid base and GGF footing. If Training Level and Introductory is very full, we may change the arena to a 20x40 meter arena to accommodate more entries. Indoor Lunging area 20m x 60m. Outdoor warm-up arena adjacent to competition arena (limited # of horses at a time) approx. 20m x 70m with hoofgrid base and GGF footing.

**AWARDS:**

- Prize to first and ribbons to six places.
- **Show High Point:** Embroidered saddle pad for Junior, Amateur and Open- both shows; awarded to the highest score of the day (freestyles, intro, Opportunity, materiale classes and Young Horse tests NOT included).
- **Freestyle Gala:** Neck ribbons and coolers for Champion and Reserve Champion.
- **Sandra McDavid Memorial Award** cooler for the Adult Amateur with best seat (awarded on Saturday evening)

**SPECIAL CLASSES:**

- Freestyle Gala (all Saturday freestyles are presented in the gala Saturday eve).
- Opportunity Training Level Tests 1 & 2 (**Class 150 & 151/250 & 251**) are classes made available for riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (USEF GR821). These entries must pay all other show related fees (office, grounds, stabling, etc.), but the Opportunity classes do not require the USEF/USDF drug fee/memberships/nonmember fees for either horse or rider/owner/trainer or coach. Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes.

- **Class 144/244** for Adult Amateur riders can be used as a qualifying for an Adult Amateur Equitation Regional Final.
- **Class 146** is an Exhibition class offering Leadline for those 10 and under. Same rules apply.

**SPECIAL EVENTS: SATURDAY: “Freestyle Gala.”** Bring your own food/drink or purchase from our food vendor. No charge to attend. Gala will start 30 minutes after last ride of the day. All Saturday Freestyle rides will be scheduled at that time. Please join us!

**OTHER:**

- **DOGS:** No dogs allowed on premises.
- **GRAZING:** ONLY in specified grazing area. Please look for signs marking grazing area!
- **PARKING:** Parking will be specific and rather tight. Please watch for attendant / signs, and be aware of special needs for all.
