Annual Report -2019

Welcome to all members, donors and well-wishers. Our UK-based charity has been helping to identify the needs of our relations at home village for the past 24 years with the tremendous contribution of all of you and has also maintaining cordial relationship with our relatives, friends and well wishes living in the UK.

We are continuously supporting number of projects in Nainativu and Vanni and also organise Pongal festival to support our younger generation to maintain our art and culture and organise sports carnival to encourage our talents in sports. These events give an opportunity to gather our relatives and friends.

Nainathivu Hospital Project

The new Board of Trustees, which took over in November 2017, fully supported the initiative of the German Red Cross to build a new hospital in Nainital and raised a large donation of £ 17,500 (€ 19,508.75) for the project to raise funds from our relations and well-wishers.

However, the Germany Red Cross said the hospital plan could not be implemented as expected and proposed an alternative plan. Donors to the hospital project have been notified of the proposal and the association will make a decision based on their choice.

Nainathivu Education Project

The Education Project initiated by the Association was able to continue with the monthly donations (£ 25) of the committee members for the educational development of the children of our village and the association is working with the idea of making the project effective.

Tree Planting Project

Some trees have grown through the tree planting project started in our village. Based on the experiences and the ideas presented at the last general meeting, we consider that the best solution in the current situation is to protect the environment and the soil by expanding tree planting in the village.

Vanni Aaputhiran Farm Project

Infrastructure facilities for the Aaputhiran Farm Project were provided by the association with the aim of improving the livelihoods of those affected by the war and the cows were procured. A fixed deposit was also made for the maintenance of the farm and handed over to the Vanni Association for the Visually Handicapped, Sri Lanka. However, we have been informed that the Vanni Association for the Visually Handicapped has faced difficulties in maintaining the cows provided by the association.

We are aware that the farm is currently cultivating vegetables and steps are being taken to raise local cows. It is the duty of the Vanni Association for the Visually Handicapped, Sri Lanka. to use the farm effectively and distribute the maximum benefit to the beneficiaries.

We urge the Vanni Association for the Visually Handicapped to reach out to other charities and stakeholders to reap the supreme benefit.
