Community Fund from Co-op


- We have submitted application to the Co-op for community fund and we have been granted £1,000 as community fund to support our local community.

- Our Sister organisation in Nainativu distributed Rs 850,000 among the affected people based on the damage of their livelihood.

Nainativu Hospital Maternity Ward Renovation

- Considering the importance of the health facilities in Nainativu, we have donated £2,500 (Rs 633,500) for the Renovation of the Maternity Ward, Nainativu Hospital.
- The renovation works has been started with the supervision of our sister organisation members and we hope that our mothers will have better medical facilities in Nainativu hospital soon.

New Projects in 2021

- Any project proposals come from Nainative will be considered on priority basis and our administrative committee will decided on funding of the projects.
- Before funding the projects, our administrative committee will appoint a team of professionals to do a feasibility study of the project to identify the sustainability of the project with the support of the beneficiaries.
- We will support for the local community by identifying their requirements
