Interoception

/ˌIn.ţə.rəˈsep.ʃən/

is the collection of <u>senses</u> providing information to the organism about the internal state of the body

your child cannot eliminate waste on their own if they do not know they need to.

your child cannot regulate themselves if they do not know what their body is feeling.

your child cannot nourish themselves if they do not recognize that they are hungry.

your child cannot rest if they do not understand that their body is tiran

your child cannot provide space. know that they need their jacket when it is cold, and no winter hat when it is hot, if they do not have bodily awareness.

you can tell them these things.

You can insist that they follow your directives.

You can give consequences if they do not follow your directives.

They still won't understand.

They are only learning to comply.

If you really want them to learn

- LET THEM MOVE FREELY
- PROVIDE AN ARRAY OF SENSORY ACTIVITIES
- LET THEM EAT WHEN THEY ARE HUNGRY
- LET THEM POTTY TRAIN WHEN THEIR BODY,
 EMOTIONS, AND PHYSICAL ABILITY IS ABLE
