- of the Association, Section B. Nominations, be amended as follows (additions are underlined;
- deletions are stricken through):

1. President-Elect and Second Vice President

- 18 Nominations for the offices of President-elect and Second Vice President shall be made in
- 19 accordance with the order of business. Candidates for these elective offices shall be nominated
- 20 from the floor of the House of Delegates by a simple declaratory statement, which may be
- 21 followed by an acceptance speech not to exceed four (4) minutes by the candidate from the
- 22 podium, according to the protocol established by the Speaker of the House of Delegates.
- 23 Seconding a nomination is not permitted.
- 24 Upon submission of required candidate documentation, nomination statements and acceptance
- 25 speeches shall be submitted electronically in video format in accordance with the protocol
- established by the Speaker of the House of Delegates. These pre-recorded materials shall be
- 27 made available to all delegates in advance of the election. No live nomination or acceptance
- speeches shall be delivered from the floor of the House of Delegates.

2. Treasurer

- 30 Each nomination may be followed by an acceptance speech not to exceed four (4) minutes by the
- 31 candidate from the podium, according to the protocol established by the Speaker of the House of
- 32 Delegates. Seconding a nomination is not permitted.
- 33 Treasurer candidates shall submit a nomination statement and acceptance speech electronically
- 34 in video format, not to exceed four (4) minutes each. These recordings shall follow a

- 1 <u>standardized protocol established by the Speaker of the House of Delegates and be made</u>
- 2 available to all delegates in advance of the election. Live speeches shall not be delivered on the
- 3 House floor.

4 3. Speaker of the House of Delegates

- 5 Each nomination may be followed by an acceptance speech not to exceed four (4) minutes by the
- 6 candidate from the podium, according to the protocol established by the Speaker of the House of
- 7 Delegates. Seconding a nomination is not permitted.
- 8 Candidates for Speaker of the House shall submit nomination and acceptance speeches in
- 9 electronic video format in accordance with protocols established by the Speaker's Office. Each
- recording shall not exceed four (4) minutes and shall be made available to delegates for review in
- advance of the vote. Live speeches shall not be delivered on the House floor.
