

Basic Pistol Marksmanship

Basic Pistol Marksmanship provides training in the safe employment of the handgun. Students learn and practice NRA approved safety protocols as well as the basics of handgun operation, and marksmanship. The two-day course incorporates lecture and practical application in a classroom and live fire range environment.

Day 1 of the course covers safety and marksmanship:

- Range safety procedures
- Safety and handling of the handgun
- Basic disassembly-assembly,
- Cleaning and maintenance
- Loading, unloading, and clearing
- Properly handling malfunctions
- Basic marksmanship with stance, presentation, grip, sight-picture, trigger manipulation, and follow through.

Day 2 of the course covers practical shooting skills:

- Working from the holster
- Varied-distance, multiple target engagements
- Tactical/speed reloading
- Movement techniques
- Injured shooter techniques
- Challenging timed-drills and stress courses.
- Whether you are a new gun owner looking for practical training, or an experienced shooter looking to refresh your basic skills, Blackmoor Technical's Basic Pistol Marksmanship is a great course to get up to speed with the handgun.

Course length: 2 days (18 hours)

Prerequisites: Legally able to own/operate a handgun

Requirements: Students should bring their own handgun, PPE (eye/hearing protection), cleaning equipment, holster, magazine pouch and at least 3 magazines

Ammunition Requirement: 500 rounds
