# **NEW FEATURE!** LEVELS 5 & 6 ONLINE PRIVATE ENGLISH SESSIONS

Feedback from teachers, parents, and students alike have led us to offer this new feature of our program: Online Private English Sessions for our students in our Levels 5 & 6.

Students will meet with their English teachers once per month for 20 minutes to discuss their submitted rough-draft writing assignments and receive personal feedback from the teacher on their writing. Student will be expected to take notes during the session, to take the teachers' suggestions, and to make the appropriate changes on their final drafts.

All sessions will be scheduled on the day of the week mentioned on the schedule; this is a separate day/time than the regular schedule.

# PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR CHILD WILL NOT MEET WITH THE TEACHER EVERY **WEEK, BUT ONCE FOR MONTH FOR A 20-MINUTE SESSION.**

The schedule mentions the timeframes when the teacher will be running the individual sessions. Students will meet for one of these sessions for 20 minutes on the day every four weeks (approximately). Students will receive their individual time slot ahead of time.

All private sessions will be ONLINE whether or not your child regularly meets in person\*

\*For Saturday (in-person) sections, the teacher may make the exception to meet in person since the student is already in the building for the class.

\*Any session missed by the student will not be accommodated.

# **How to Read** the Schedule:
