## Writing 2: Writing for College Admissions and Future Careers

Semester 2: SAT and ACT Essays (for Grades 10-12)

This semester course will cover SAT and ACT essays. Mastering these essays will not only help students on the ACT essay component; it will also help them with fundamental essay writing skills they need in high school and college. Students will improve their writing pieces through weekly feedback from the teacher and their peers.

This is a small-group class, structured similarly to a writing group. Students are expected to bring their writing assignment each week to share with the class. They are expected to give and accept feedback from the teacher and their peers. This small-group class structure provides an ideal environment for writing improvement.

Important Notes: Although this is Part 2 of the Writing II course, new students are welcome to join. We are starting fresh with a new unit; new students do not need the knowledge of the previous material to succeed. They are welcome to take Part 1 (College and Job Applications) at another semester if desired.

The SAT is no longer requiring the essay component. However, mastering this essay (also known as a rhetorical analysis essay) is still meaningful, as it is a common essay assigned in high school and college and provides students with important analytical and communication skills.
