### AP Precalculus / Precalculus / TJ Math 4

This class is intended to prepare students for the AP Precalculus Test in May 2024. This course gives the students a head start with the concepts taught in Precalculus course, and helps them gain a thorough understanding of Pre-Calculus concepts necessary for success in higher level math courses like AP Calculus AB/BC. Students who are currently enrolled in Precalculus or Algebra 2 in school can take this course. Our program will help prepare students for this high-school-credit math class (which affects their high school GPA). Not only will we give the students a head start with the concepts taught in any Pre-Calculus course, we will help them to transition into an advanced Pre-Calculus course by expecting a certain degree of rigor and independent learning skills. Also, gaining a thorough understanding of Pre-Calculus concepts is necessary to prepare for higher level math courses like AP Calculus, Calculus AB/BC, and AP Statistics.

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


