

Regina Slopitch Tournament Rules

Welcome to the Regina Slopitch Association Final Tournament! Each team is guaranteed 2 games. Each game will be under a time limit, so no new inning shall be started after 60 minutes past the **scheduled start time**. Please exit the dugouts promptly to allow the next team to get set up. Please try to be ready to play 10 minutes before your scheduled time on the tournament bracket so that as soon as the game before you has finished, you can begin your game and hopefully keep us on schedule

Please check in at the Regina Slopitch table when you arrive. All team captains must have signed the waiver before their team will be allowed to partake in the weekend's events. Regina Slopitch Association is not responsible for any personal injury that may occur before, during, or after the tournament.

Captains pre-game meeting

Captains should discuss any obstruction in the field prior to the game and determine what course of action will be played if the obstruction interferes with the play. Ex. automatic dead ball if the ball lands in a puddle.

If there is no commitment line or home plate equivalent line drawn in the dirt, please do so at this time.

Whichever team seeded higher in the standings, will be the home team. If both teams were seeded the same in their respective divisions, a coin flip will determine which team is home for that game.

Batting order/Roster

Will be the same as regular season rules

*exception: 10 Batters max in all innings. The final innings will no longer be open.

Offense

Will be the same as regular season rules

Defence

Will be the same as regular season rules

Tie Breaker

In the result of a tie after what should be the final inning, teams will play another inning until the tie is broken. Teams will begin this inning with the last batter from the previous inning starting on 2nd base, and 1 out. If the runner who begins on 2nd has been using a pinch runner throughout the game, the pinch runner for the additional inning must be the player immediately before them in the batting order, regardless of gender.

Unsportsmanlike conduct

In the event that Regina Slopitch management feels a player is displaying unsportsmanlike conduct on the field, they may intervene and bench the player for one inning in hopes to de-escalate the situation. If the behaviour continues, the player may be asked to leave the tournament.

In the event of athletic fields closing on the day of the tournament, we will come up with an alternative plan to wrap up the year.
