Anatomy, Physiology, and Structural Kinesiology, Theory and Demonstration of Massage which includes: The proper procedure in massaging (concerning the protection of both the client and massage therapist for the specific condition; contraindications of massage);record keeping; hygiene; theory; techniques according to conditions; draping; and assessment of the client's condition and general technique to be applied. Swedish massage, including trigger points, lymphatic drainage, prenatal massage, deep tissue, Muscle Energy Technique, range of motion and stretching. Seated Chair massages, Medical Massage, Sport massage, preevent, post-event, rehabilitation and injury prevention, Acupressure, Five element Chinese Medicine and meridians, Energy techniques such as chakra balancing, how to use healing touch, and Breath work.
