

When the sun sets in Orlando, the real mysteries check in. These luxurious properties offer more than just plush pillows—they come with stories, secrets, and perhaps a few spectral guests who never quite checked out.



The Edgewater Hotel (Winter Garden)

99 W Plant St, Winter Garden 4-Star | Est. 1927

This beautifully restored boutique hotel whispers stories from the Jazz Age. Once a favorite of traveling businessmen and vaudevillians, the Edgewater is rumored to house more than a few lingering spirits. Guests report creaking floors, flickering lights, and cold spots in Room 203. Perfect for the sleuth who likes their stay with a side of séance.



The Alfond Inn at Rollins (Winter Park)

300 E New England Ave, Winter Park 4-Star | Est. 2013 (but on storied land)

Though newer in construction, this award-winning luxury hotel sits on ground steeped in Winter Park history—once home to boarding houses and secret societies tied to Rollins College. The on-site art collection is so captivating, some say the eyes follow you. And if you hear whispering in the library? Don't worry. Probably just the alumni... from the 1800s.



The Grand Bohemian Hotel (Downtown Orlando)

325 S Orange Ave, Orlando
4.5-Star | Est. 2001 (built in homage to Old World glamour)
Red velvet, gilded frames, and a piano bar that feels straight out of a noir film—this swanky Kessler Collection property oozes mysterious elegance. Built atop historic downtown land, staff and guests have shared tales of shadowy figures in mirrors and vintage perfume wafting from empty elevators. Come for the martinis—stay for the mystery.



DAYTIME INVESTIGATIONS

When the sun's up, it's time to pound the pavement...

American Ghost Adventures — Downtown Orlando Tour 129 W Church St, Orlando

This isn't your run-of-the-mill"walk and gawk"ghost tour. Led by passionate paranormal investigators, American Ghost Adventures takes you beyond the lore and into the shadows of downtown Orlando's most haunted landmarks. Guests are equipped with real ghost-hunting equipment and access to historic buildings not open to the public. Expect chilling tales of unsolved murders, mob connections, and lingering spirits who still roam Church Street Station. Tip: Wear comfortable shoes—and maybe don't go alone.

Leu Gardens

1920 N Forest Ave, Orlando
Is that a rare orchid or a coded message in the conservatory?
This lush estate is the perfect place to cool down—or bury secrets.

Orlando Museum of Art

2416 N Mills Ave, Orlando Art... or clues? Keep an eye out for symbolism, hidden messages, and suspiciously familiar faces in the portraits.

Hanson's Shoe Repair

27 E Pine St, Orlando
Password required. DM them on Instagram or follow the whispers. This historic haunt hides behind a shoe shop façade—and maybe a killer's confession.

The Ravenous Pig (Winter Park)

565 W Fairbanks Ave, Winter Park A classy yet cozy gastropub known for seasonal fare and a moody ambiance. Try the truffle fries—word is, they've been bribing cops with them for years.

Santiago's Bodega (Orlando & Altamonte)

802 Virginia Dr, Orlando Tapas and a strong pour? It's the kind of place where deals go down over bacon-wrapped dates and sangria.

Mathers Social Gathering

30 S Magnolia Ave, Orlando Hidden upstairs in a 1800s-era furniture store, this speakeasy-style lounge is dripping with velvet, chandeliers, and mystery. Dress the part—1920s attire encouraged.

Better Than Sex – A Dessert Restaurant

> 1905 N Orange Ave, Orlando You didn't hear it from us, but some say a murder was plotted over a chocolate-dipped Cabernet. The most decadent desserts in the city - strictly for grown-ups.



DINE LIKE A MOB BOSS

The BOATHOUSE® (Disney Springs)

1620 E Buena Vista Dr, Lake Buena Vista
This upscale waterfront spot is equal parts seafood haven and nautical museum. Dine beside vintage amphicars and yachts, sip cocktails dockside, and watch the sun dip below Lake Buena Vista.
The lobster roll's a standout, but don't skip the Old Fashioned—served with maritime swagger.

Maxine's on Shine

337 Shine Ave, Orlando

A romantic retro hideaway that feels like a cabaret stumbled into your grandmother's parlor. With live music, Sunday brunches, and strong drinks, it's a local favorite for date nights and mischief. Sit on the patio, order the "Foreplay" charcuterie board, and lose track of time.

Enzo's on the Lake

1130 S US Hwy 1792, Longwood

Tucked away in a vintage lakefront house north of Orlando, Enzo's serves up classic Italian dishes with an old-world charm. Picture candlelight, Chianti, and a lake breeze that makes secrets easier to spill. It's where mob wives might meet to "talk business" over baked ziti.

The Monroe

448 N Terry Ave, Orlando

Inside a reimagined mid-century building in Creative Village, The Monroe blends modern comfort with retro cool. Southern fare, craft cocktails, and a backroom bar that feels like a 1950s social club. Order the fried chicken and keep your ears open—someone's always talking shop in the corner booth.
