
OUR WORK

- Assisted over 50 families with building materials, appliances, car replacement, household goods and repairs following Hurricane Ian totaling \$162,062.
- Hosted 15 volunteer teams who together with local volunteers logged 8660 hours of service providing assessments, case management and repairs.
- Provided water, tarps, flood buckets, tornado buckets and food items to 163 families following Hurricane Idalia.
- Assisted 107 families with debris cleanup following Hurricane Idalia providing 3360 hours of volunteer service.

We are continuing to work with the ongoing recovery efforts in the Taylor County area. Six trained volunteer Family Advocates are assisting 24 families to identify unmet needs and match resources available to restore, repair or rebuild their homes. New referrals come in each day as folks still struggle to recover from Hurricane Idalia. Your prayers and support are appreciated.
