Faith Responders in 2024 (our first year):

- Responded to or assisted in 6 storms: Tallahassee Tornadoes, Miami Flooding, Ruidoso Wildfires, Hurricane Debby, Hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton
- Provided Training and Orientations for 225 volunteers
- Participated in two Annual Conference events
- Received and distributed 1800 cleaning buckets
- Received and distributed over 78 pallets of food items, cleaning supplies, household items, water, Gatorade, shovels, diapers and baby items, hygiene supplies and other items
- Distributed \$13,385.00 in Gift Cards
- Provided \$36,740.76 in direct assistance to families
- Assisted 217 families with debris cleanup, muckouts, chainsaw work, tarping and repairs
- Provided disaster case management to 48 families in Taylor County
- Provided over 10,686 hours of volunteer service
- Were 1 of 10 organizations to received \$50,000 Grant from The Florida Governor's Fund
- Received over \$500,000 in donations for direct assistance and general funds which have been designated for assistance to Hurricane Helene and Milton Survivors in Florida, Georgia, Tennessee and North Carolina
