What you will need:

RED HEART® With Love®: 6 skeins 1505 Peacock

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 1 ripple = 6½" (16.5 cm) from peak to peak; 6 rows = 3½" (9 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**



RED HEART® With Love®, Art. E400 available in solid color 7oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m) and multicolor 5oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) skeins

Elegant Ripples Throw

This one-color ripple is perfectly suited to today's easy-living interiors. The classic crochet chevron pattern is highlighted with textured post stitch rows for unusual style. It's ideal for any room and any home.

Throw measures: 45" wide x 56" long (114.5 cm x 142 cm).

Notes

1. Throw is made in a ripple pattern which consists of a series of 3-stitch "peaks" and 2-skipped-stitch "valleys", with 12 dc worked between peaks and valleys. You may need to work several rows before the ripple is clearly visible.
2. To lengthen the throw, repeat Rows 2-25. Lengthening the throw may require the purchase of additional yarn.

Special Stitches

Bpdc (back post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch "in front of" the Bpdc.

Fpdc (front post double crochet) = Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).

THROW

With **A**, ch 191.

Row 1 (wrong side): Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, *sc in next 12 ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in next 12 ch, 3 sc in next ch; repeat from * 5 times, sc in next 12 ch, skip next 2 ch, sc in next 12 ch, 2 sc in last ch, turn—190 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st here or throughout), 2 dc in first st, *dc in next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, dc in next 12 sts, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * 5 times, dc in next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, *sc in next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, sc in next 12 sts, 3 sc in next st; repeat from * 5 times, sc in next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, sc in next 12 sts, 2 sc in last st, turn.

Rows 4-9: Repeat last 2 rows 3 times.

Rows 10 and 11: Repeat Row 2.

Row 12: Ch 2, 2 dc in first st, *bpdc around next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, bpdc around next 12 sts, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * 5 times, bpdc around next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, bpdc around next 12 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn.

Row 13: Ch 2, 2 dc in first st, *fpdc around next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, fpdc around next 12 sts, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * 5 times, fpdc around next 12 sts, skip next 2 sts, fpdc around next 12 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn.

Rows 14 and 15: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 16 and 17: Repeat Rows 12 and 13.

Rows 18-21: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 twice.

Row 22: Repeat Row 2.

Row 23: Repeat Row 13.

Row 24: Repeat Row 12.

Row 25: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 26-97: Repeat Rows 2-25 three times.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet;
sc = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
* = repeat whatever follows the * as
indicated.
