The San Mateo County Alkathon was started 1975 to provide around the clock meetings during the holidays of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's.

Our location, since 1979, is the Good Shepherd Episcopal Church located at 1300 5th Ave, Belmont, aka "5th and O'Neil"



Meetings start every even hour on the following days:

Christmas A.A. Alkathon Thurs, Dec 24, 12PM - Sat, Dec 26, 12PM
New Year's A.A. Alkathon Thurs Dec 31, 12PM - Sat Jan 2, 12PM

Each meeting is 90 minutes except for our closing meeting which is 60 minutes.
There are 30-minute breaks between meetings for fellowship.

Hosting an Alkathon meeting is similar to running a speaker meeting, the difference being some added service positions and food. The groups are requested to consider providing food items relevant to the time they are hosting. The Alkathon Committee provides coffee, tea, all the needed supplies and a kitchen crew to assist groups with food. The Alkathon Committee also has a food budget to assist groups who may be unable to consider the food request but traditionally the meetings sponsoring bring food.
