Rules:

This show is strictly for fun and to get the community excited about having local horse shows again!

- Ride-A-Buck: Each person will ride bareback and tuck a dollar bill under their leg.
 The last person with their dollar still under their leg wins all the dollars in the pen.
 This class is strictly bareback. You may not wet your horse or your bill. The show will provide the "dollars".
- Double Bareback: Aside from the obvious, each team will be required to perform a rail class, double bareback. This will be a judged show. If you fall off, you are disqualified. If you fail to perform a maneuver in a timely manner, you are disqualified.
- Egg & Spoon: just as it sounds, you will do a rail class while carrying an egg in a spoon. The last one with the egg still in their spoon wins.
- Musical Horses: there will be a chalk box on the ground next to a number on the rail.
 When the music stops, last one without at least 2 feet in the box, is out.
- Boot race: this is an unmounted race where all the boots go in a pile. First one to put on both their boots and run back wins!
- Capture the Flag: Run to far barrel, pick up a flag, run around close barrel and back to far barrel, put the flag back in the bucket and run back.
- Steady Eddy: This class is where each person carries a cup full of water while doing a rail class, at the end of the class, the person with the most water wins.
- Stick Horse Class: whether you bring one of your own or your use one of our's, the purpose is to have a rail class while riding a stick horse!

Negative coggins is required. Boots must be worn in all classes. No shorts please.
