## FUNDRAISER FREESTYLE TOC CLASS ENTRY FORM

Riders are required to wear protective headgear, regardless of level. Costumed participation is permitted and encouraged, but please keep the safety and well-being of yourself and your horse as a top priority. The class winner will be based on the total of funds raised, through the rider's own fundraising and cash collected on the rider's behalf during the RFL party, to be held immediately after the conclusion of the Fundraiser Freestyle Class.
- Riders raising a minimum of \$100 are eligible for a special **Rider Gifts**, designed to reward fundraising efforts.
- Riders in the Fundraiser Freestyle are eligible for High Pledge Awards.
- PVDA, USDF, AND/OR USEF MEMBERSHIPS ARE NOT REQUIRED
