Stephanie works in the Kitchen at the Coal Bucket Restaurant and was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis in 2017. Since then, she has tried to raise awareness about this unpredictable disease & the impact it can have on those who live with it, and their families. MS, an unpredictable, often disabling disease of the central nervous system, interrupts the flow of information within the brain to the rest of the body. Symptoms range from numbness & tingling to blindness & paralysis. MS affects more than 2.3 million people worldwide & nearly 1 million people in the U.S. Most people with MS are diagnosed between the ages of 20 & 50, with @ least 2 to 3 times more women than men. The progress, severity, & specific symptoms of MS in any 1 person cannot yet be predicted, but advances in research & treatment are leading to a better understanding & moving us closer to a world free of MS.

KITZMILLER HEAD START

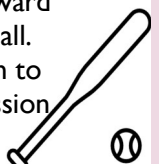

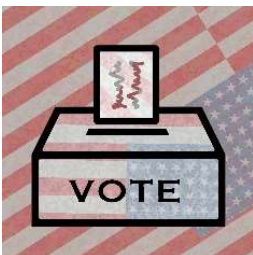
