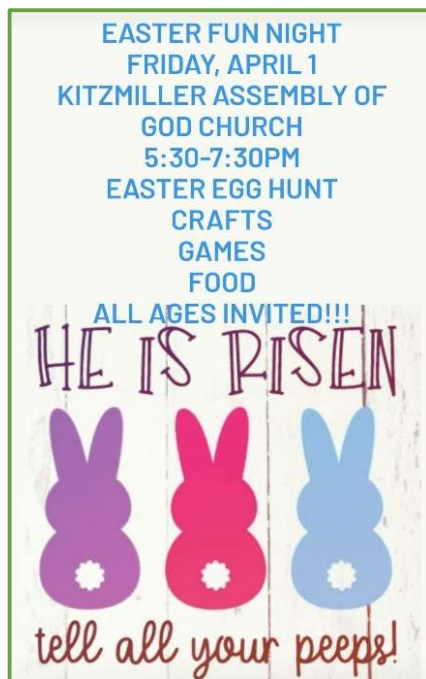

registering to run for council, you **MUST** contact Beccie at the Town Hall.

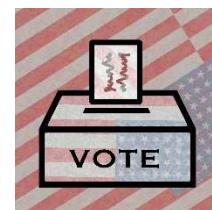
**Deadline to register will be Tuesday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.**
