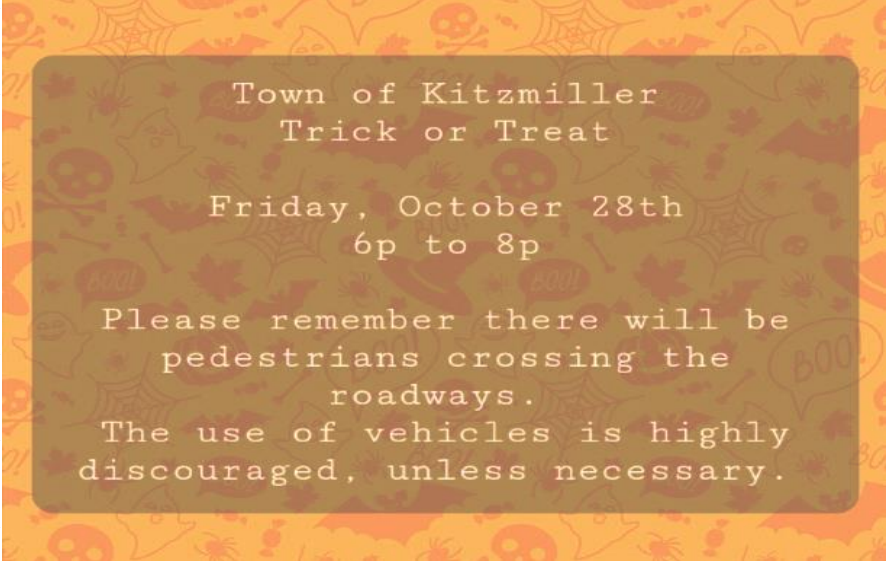

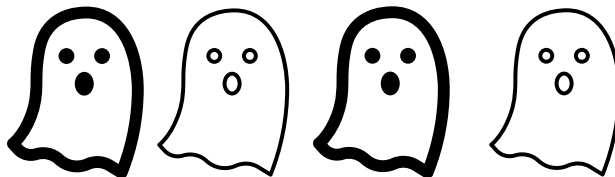
- Did you know these three locations of the medication drop boxes?

There are a lot of things happening in our wonderful community! Storm Drainage has been an issue that we [The Mayor and Council] have been working on. We are currently waiting on a few estimates to come back for some of the projects we have in mind.

With trick or treat coming up, there are a few things I would like to remind everyone of:

1. PLEASE do not park on the sidewalks. The town puts thousands of dollars into our sidewalks and driving on them contributes to quicker deterioration.
2. PLEASE do not park in front of the Fire Hydrants. They are there for the Fire Department for easy access in case of an emergency.

Watch for electrical upgrades to be made to the park and the installation of the new streetlights. We finally got the approval for the USDA Grant for the New Dump Truck!

We were also awarded a grant for the removal and installation of new playground equipment at the school. Volunteers will be needed to prepare for this project. I look forward to seeing everyone during our Autumn Glory Event on Friday, October 14th.
