- Kitzmiller United Methodist church – Worship begins Sunday at 9 AM.

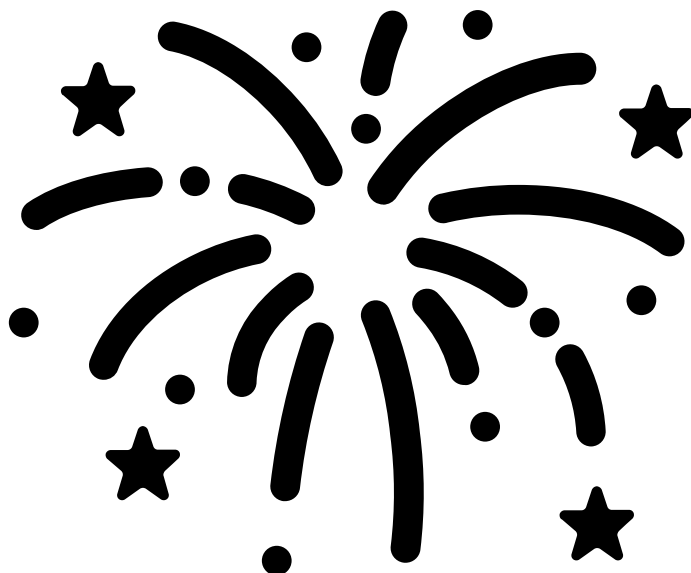
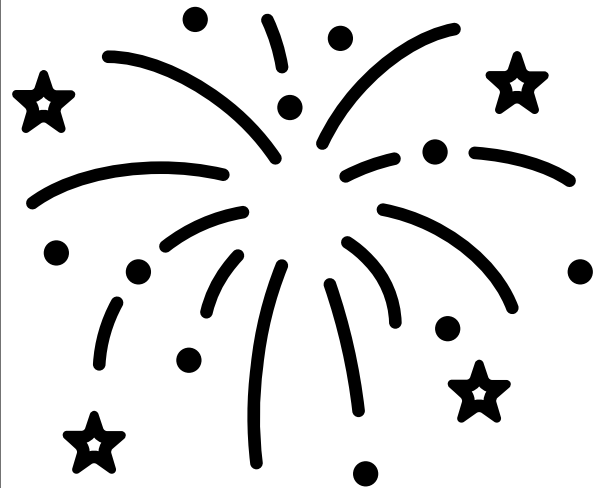

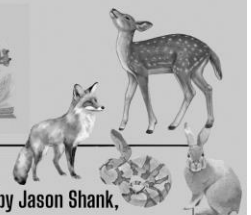
