Resolution Title: Support for the Updated Garrett County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2024

THIS IS A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Town Council of Kitzmiller adopting the Garrett County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, updated in 2024.

WHEREAS the Mayor and Town Council of Kitzmiller recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to the residents, people, and property within the Town of Kitzmiller; and

WHEREAS the town has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Garrett County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, updated in 2024, in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS The mitigation plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to the residents, people, and property in the town from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Mayor and Town Council of Kitzmiller, Maryland demonstrates its commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlies in the Garrett County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, updated in 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED on this 28th day in the month of October, of the year 2024 by a vote of 3 in favor and 0 against (with none abstaining), the Mayor and Town Council of Kitzmiller formally adopts the Garrett County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, updated in 2024, for the Town of Kitzmiller, Maryland. While the content related to the town may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after this adoption will not require the Mayor and Town Council to readopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
