Pending results should be posted no later than 8PM outside the town hall by the Election

Supervisor & Judges.

Every person who (1) is a citizen of the United States, (2) is at least eighteen years of age,
(3) has resided in the State of Maryland for at least one year next preceding any town election,
(4) has resided within the corporate limits of the town for thirty days next preceding any town
election, and (5) is registered in accordance with the provisions of this charter, is a qualified
voter of the town. Every qualified voter of the town is entitled to vote at all town elections.
YOU MUST BE REGISTERED TO VOTE THROUGH THE TOWN, THE DAY PRIOR TO ELECTIONS.
