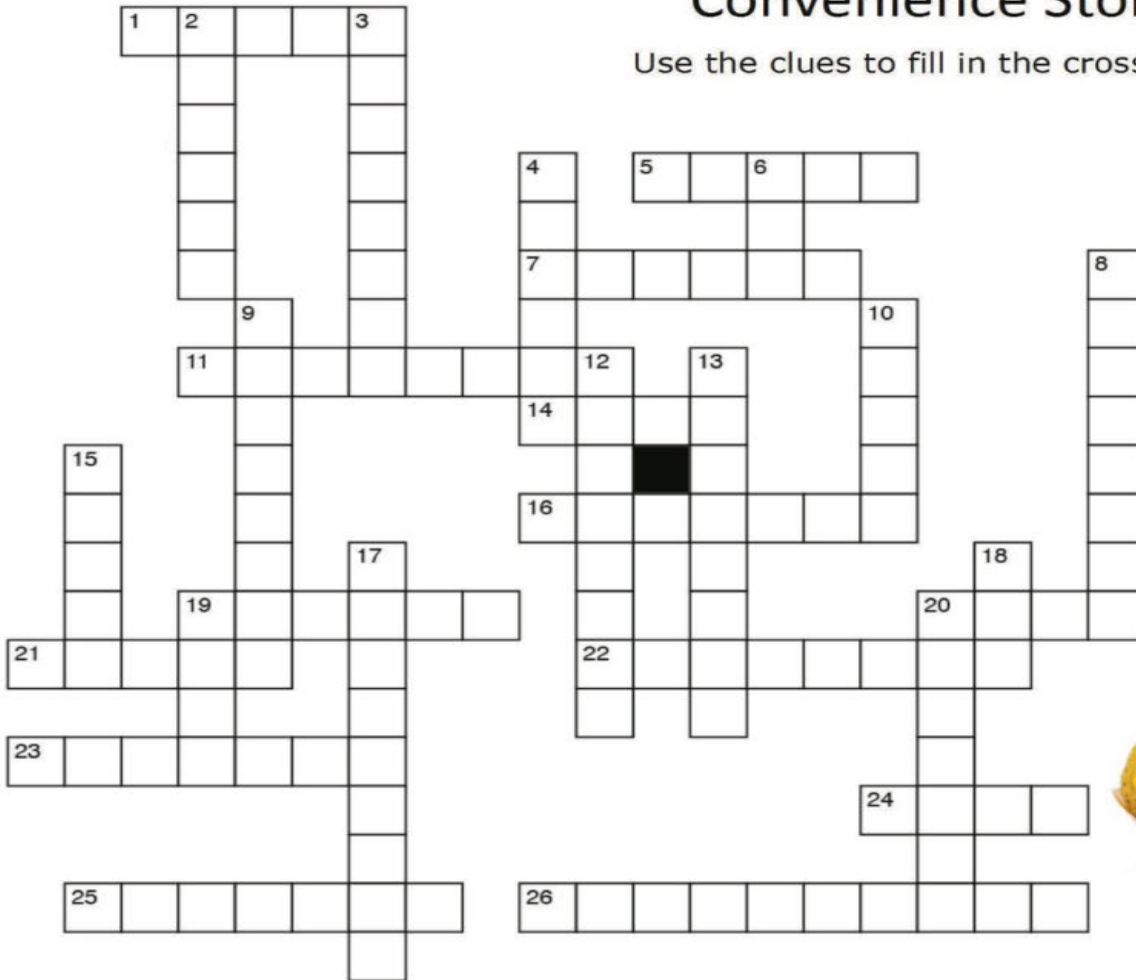

## C.A.L.L. Ministry

C.A.L.L. Ministry's mission is to reduce the financial burdens of the low-income citizens of Mercer County. Did you know C.A.L.L. has a "Work 4 Program" in addition to their main mission, the food pantry?



The "Work 4 Program" allows clients to donate hours at the pantry in exchange for a donated appliance. When an appliance is donated, it is cleaned, inspected, and stored until a request for one comes from a client. The client then works at the pantry, usually 5 to 8 hours to 'earn' the item. Once it has been earned they can take the item home.

In addition to appliances, C.A.L.L. also accept vehicles. The vehicle is inspected and verified to be roadworthy. Clients in need of a vehicle are required to fill out an application. Applications are reviewed for situations that are the most beneficial for clients in need. Chosen applicants must agree to donate eighty (80) hours of volunteer work at the pantry. At the completion of this work, the title is transferred to the new owner.

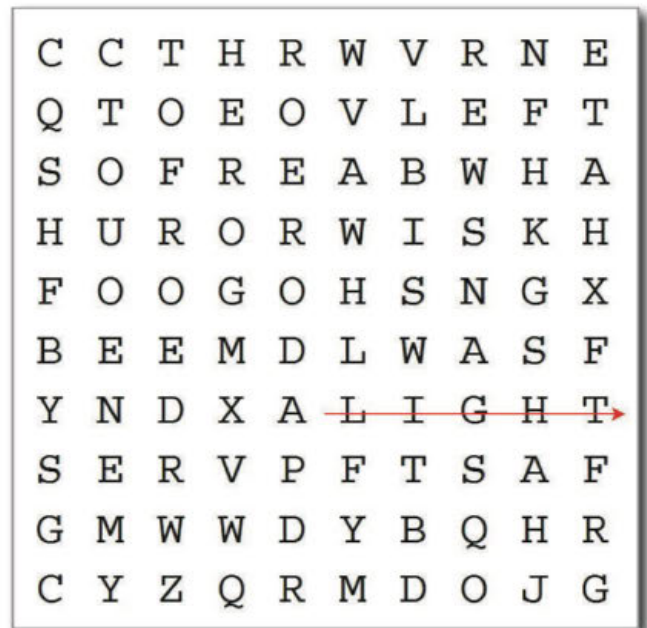
