## **Free Loan Program!**

Did you know that the MCCoA has a program to provide seniors in Mercer County with the use of many types of durable medical equipment. It's called our free loan program. There is no cost for you to take part in this program, it is **FREE!** Mercer County residents, over 60 years old, living in their own home are eligible to take part in this program. We offer a variety of items such as canes, walkers, rollators, wheelchairs, shower chairs, bedside commodes and toilet risers for your use. Many times these items are needed for only a short period of time, such as after surgery or during rehab. Stop by the office to see our inventory and sign out the equipment that can assist you during your recovery. Items are loaned for a 6-month period. If you need it longer, simply call the office and ask to renew the loan. Along with the free loan equipment we also have a great chore crew that can install grab bars to assist you in your home.

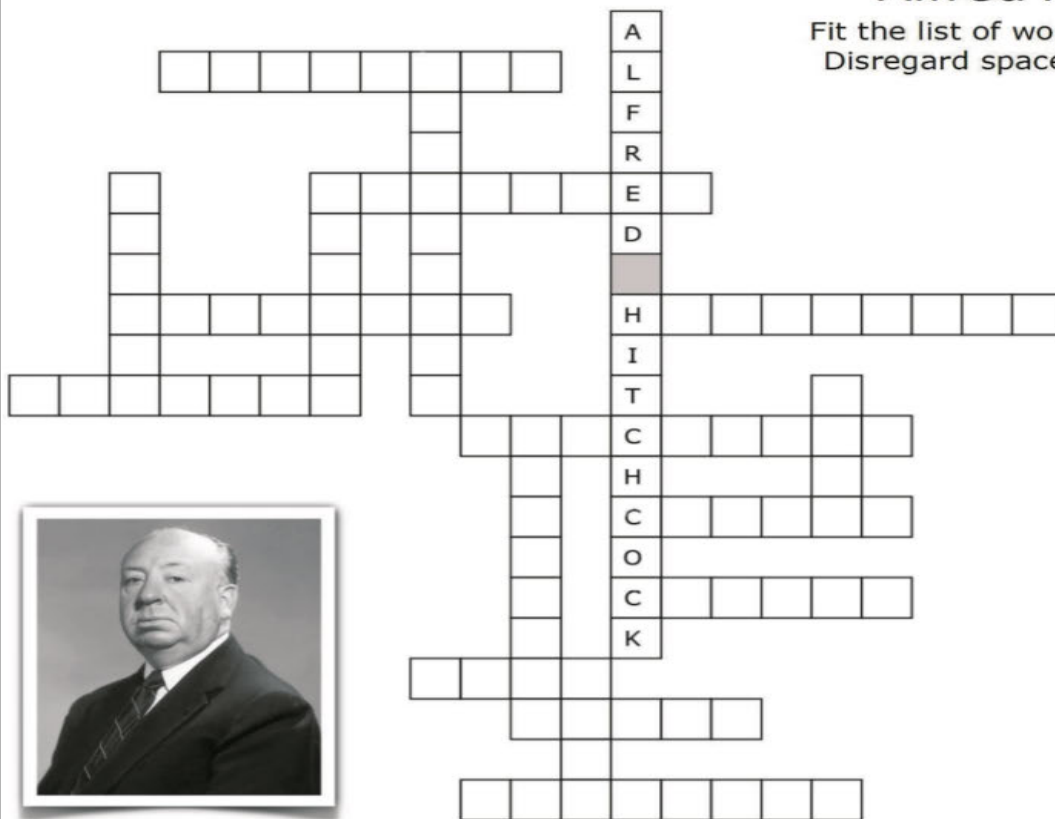

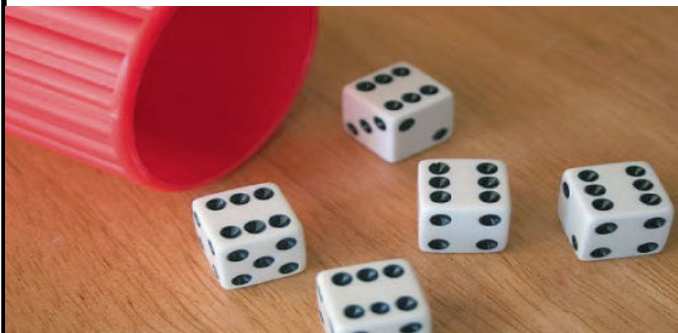
### Craft Class
