
From the Director's Desk:

MVP Dairy is a partnership between two 4th generation farming families, the McCarty Family of Kansas and the VanTilburg Family of Ohio. MVP Dairy is home to 4,400 Holstein cows that are milked on a state-of-the-art 80-stall milking carousel. They are housed in six tunnel-ventilated freestall barns; furnished with sand bedding, misters, and fans and even cow brushes to scratch their backs.

Our day will begin with an open-house style visit from 8:00-10:00AM. Shuttles for barn tours will be running every 30 minutes & you'll be able to explore the Dairy Learning Center & see the cows being milked. The Dairy Learning Center at MVP Dairy is a 501c3 non-profit dedicated to providing valuable learning experiences for young agricultural professionals & our community through farm tours, internships & scholarships. The Learning Center has been open for about 6 years and has had more than 45,000 visitors of all ages and backgrounds.
