Niagara Falls – Canada

A Passport or Passport Card is required for travel into Canada and re-entry to the U.S.

Tuesday - Friday, May 19-22, 2026

Tuesday, May 19th

- 7:25 – 8:05 am Pickups will be in Celina, St Marys, and Wapakoneta. Exact pickup times will be determined approximately 30 days prior to trip departure.
Lunch included enroute at Golden Corral.
- 4:00 pm Check into the 4-Star Fallsview Hilton, Niagara's premier upscale resort. The world-class Fallsview Casino is adjacent to our hotel.
Dinner on your own.
- This Evening Tour Niagara Parks Power Station. From the most towering turbine to the tiniest detail, uncover fascinating stories hidden within the historic Niagara Parks Power Station, a new must-see attraction. Descend 180-feet in a glass-paneled elevator and explore the 2,200-foot-long tunnel, leading to an observation deck at the river's edge. Explore the first major power plant on the Canadian side of the Niagara River with immersive exhibits, restored artifacts and interactive storytelling.

- Evening Dinner included at the Skylon Tower, high above The Falls. The restaurant rotates for incredible views.



Thursday, May 21st

- Late Afternoon Visit Peller Estate Winery, one of Canada's award-winning upscale wineries. Our visit includes a tour and tasting.
- Evening Enjoy included dinner at a local restaurant in Niagara-on-the-Lake. Return to the Hotel in Niagara Falls after dinner.



Friday, May 22nd

- 8:15 am Depart hotel for Lockport Locks and Erie Canal Cruise and lunch.
- 9:30 am Enjoy a fun and informative cruise that takes you past five of the original 1800's locks. Three million gallons of water will fill Locks 34 & 35, the only double set on the Erie Canal, and raise the boat 50 feet. You'll pass under Lockport's

"Upside Down Bridge," Lockport's "Big Bridge" (the widest bridge in the U.S. at 399 feet wide), through the "deep rock cut" and under lift bridges. The lively narration by the Coast Guard Licensed Captains is also accompanied by crowd-pleasing canal music, popular during the 1800's.

11:30 am Enjoy included buffet lunch after the cruise.

1:00 pm Depart for home.

Fast food dinner stop on your own enroute.

8:15 – 9:00 pm Approximate time to return home depending upon our pickup location.

- Deposit required within 14 days of making your reservation to confirm your reservation.
- Balance due 7/3/26. Additional trip information and billing will be sent at that time.
- List of passenger names will be included in final billing.
- **Cancellation Policy - Deposit fully refundable up to 61 days prior to trip departure; 60-31 days - 25% of your trip cost is non-refundable, 30-15 days prior to departure– 50% of your trip cost is non-refundable; 14 days prior to departure – 100% of trip cost is non-refundable. If replacement is found, you will be refunded all your money except for a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee.**
- If less than 30 passengers sign up for this trip, MCCOA reserves the right to cancel the trip or make any necessary changes to conduct the trip with a reduced number of passengers.
- Parking will be available in the parking lots at all locations. **Please plan to arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.**
- The dress for attractions is casual.
- You can bring snacks and drinks on the bus.
