Tuesday - Friday, May 19-22, 2026

Tuesday, May 19th

- 7:25 – 8:05 am Pickups will be in Celina, St Marys, and Wapakoneta. Exact pickup times will be determined approximately 30 days prior to trip departure.
Lunch included enroute at Golden Corral.
- Late afternoon Visit and tour the Teddy Roosevelt Inaugural Site. Experience TR's unusual 1901 inauguration like never before. On a guided tour experience historically restored rooms and interactive exhibits. You'll feel as if you were part of the events of that fateful September, while gaining a new perspective on the issues Roosevelt faced during his presidency.

- Afternoon Visit Cave of the Winds. This breathtaking attraction will take you down 175 feet to the foot of Bridal Veil Falls. Walk out on to Hurricane Deck and literally "Touch the Falls."
- Mid Afternoon Enjoy the Maid of the Mist Boat Cruise. This exhilarating experience brings us to the brink of the Horseshoe Falls as we hear the roar of 650,000 gallons of water come crashing down per second.
- Evening Dinner included this evening at The Top of the Falls Restaurant. Floor-to-ceiling windows provide viewing of Horseshoe Falls.



Thursday, May 21st

- Buffet Breakfast included at the hotel.
- Morning Tour the Niagara Power Vista, featuring over 50 interactive exhibits. Receive a hands-on understanding of electricity and hydroelectricity.
- Late Morning Tour the Basilica of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. Fifteen acres of gardens are highlighted by an awe-inspiring glass Dome Basilica topped by a 13-foot statue of Our Lady Fatima. Over 100 life-size statues, natural pond and a heart shaped Rosary pool offer a haven for reflection. Lunch included at the Basilica.
- Afternoon Tour Old Fort Niagara. The historic grounds include 18th-century fortifications and several original buildings. Learn what daily life was like for the men and women that lived in service.
- Late Afternoon Visit Bella Rose Winery for a tasting experience.
- Early Evening Return to hotel. Dinner and evening on your own.

Friday, May 22nd

- Breakfast included at the hotel.
- 8:15 am Depart hotel for Lockport Locks and Erie Canal Cruise and lunch.
- 9:30 am Enjoy a fun and informative cruise that takes you past five of the original 1800's locks. Three million gallons of water will fill Locks 34 & 35, the only double set on the Erie Canal, and raise the boat 50 feet. You'll pass under Lockport's

"Upside Down Bridge," Lockport's "Big Bridge" (the widest bridge in the U.S. at 399 feet wide), through the "deep rock cut" and under lift bridges. The lively narration by the Coast Guard Licensed Captains is also accompanied by crowd-pleasing canal music, popular during the 1800's.

11:30 am Enjoy included buffet lunch after the cruise.

1:00 pm Depart for home.

Fast food dinner stop on your own enroute.

8:15 – 9:00 pm Approximate time to return home depending upon our pickup location.

- Deposit required within 14 days of making your reservation to confirm your reservation.
- Balance due 7/3/26. Additional trip information and billing will be sent at that time.
- List of passenger names will be included in final billing.
- **Cancellation Policy - Deposit fully refundable up to 61 days prior to trip departure; 60-31 days - 25% of your trip cost is non-refundable, 30-15 days prior to departure– 50% of your trip cost is non-refundable; 14 days prior to departure – 100% of trip cost is non-refundable. If replacement is found, you will be refunded all your money except for a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee.**
- If less than 30 passengers sign up for this trip, MCCOA reserves the right to cancel the trip or make any necessary changes to conduct the trip with a reduced number of passengers.
- Parking will be available in the parking lots at all locations. **Please plan to arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.**
- The dress for attractions is casual.
- You can bring snacks and drinks on the bus.
