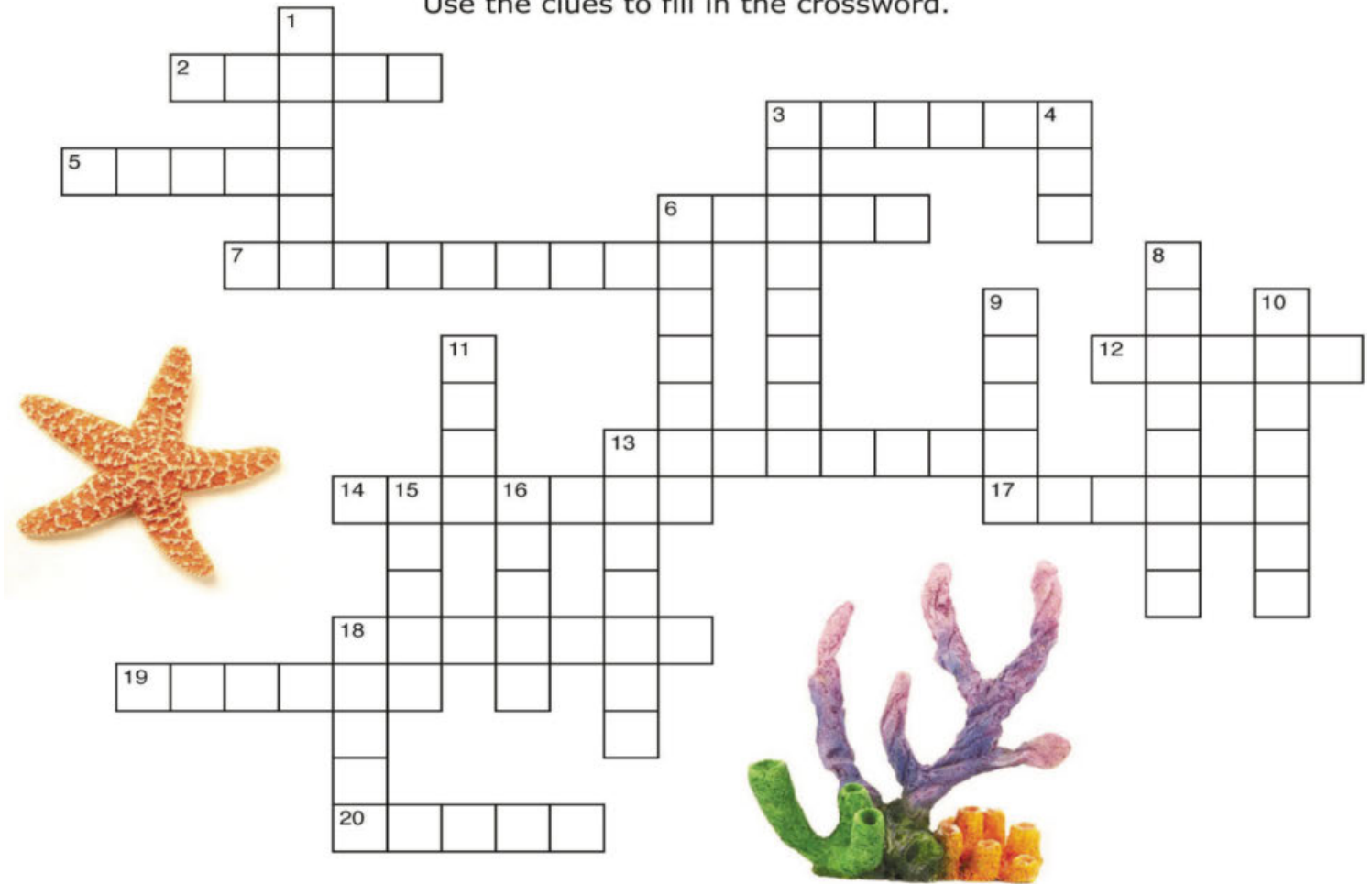

## Fitness Center - New Equipment

The Mercer County Commissioners have granted us the opportunity to add two new pieces of exercise equipment to our fitness center using funds from the Healthy Aging Grant. Join us **Monday, June 10 at 1:00 pm** as John Gordan, president of Gordan Medical, and Scott Uhlenhake, physical therapist with Mor Rehab, teach us how to benefit using the StepOne and the Pro 2 Total Body Trainer. **Thank you Commissioners and JFS for doing the work to make it happen!!**

StepOne is a uniquely designed Seated Stepper device that allows for natural movements of both arms and legs which simulates normal walking and stair climbing motions. With bilateral limb exercising, both legs and arms move in linear fashions, efficiently exercising both legs and arms at the same time.

The Pro 2 Total Body Trainer is an exerciser of reciprocal actions of both arms and legs. Like a lower and upper body bicycle. It is similar to the StepOne only not in the linear motion, but in a circular one.

There are 200 levels of resistance which afford small incremental improvements, this helps in positive reinforcements of all successes, even small ones. Having a very low amount of starting resistance allows deconditioned users the opportunity to use them as well. By removing the device's seat and rolling a wheelchair into position, these machines offer wheelchair bound users the opportunity to enjoy the benefits. Adjustable arms allow comfortable hand positioning and proper fit for users. The

machines can also accommodate various stride lengths that make stepping very natural by allowing users the adjust the stride length to match their ability. There are multiple programs that use a simple and easy Start mode for quick exercising.

### Alzheimer's Support Group

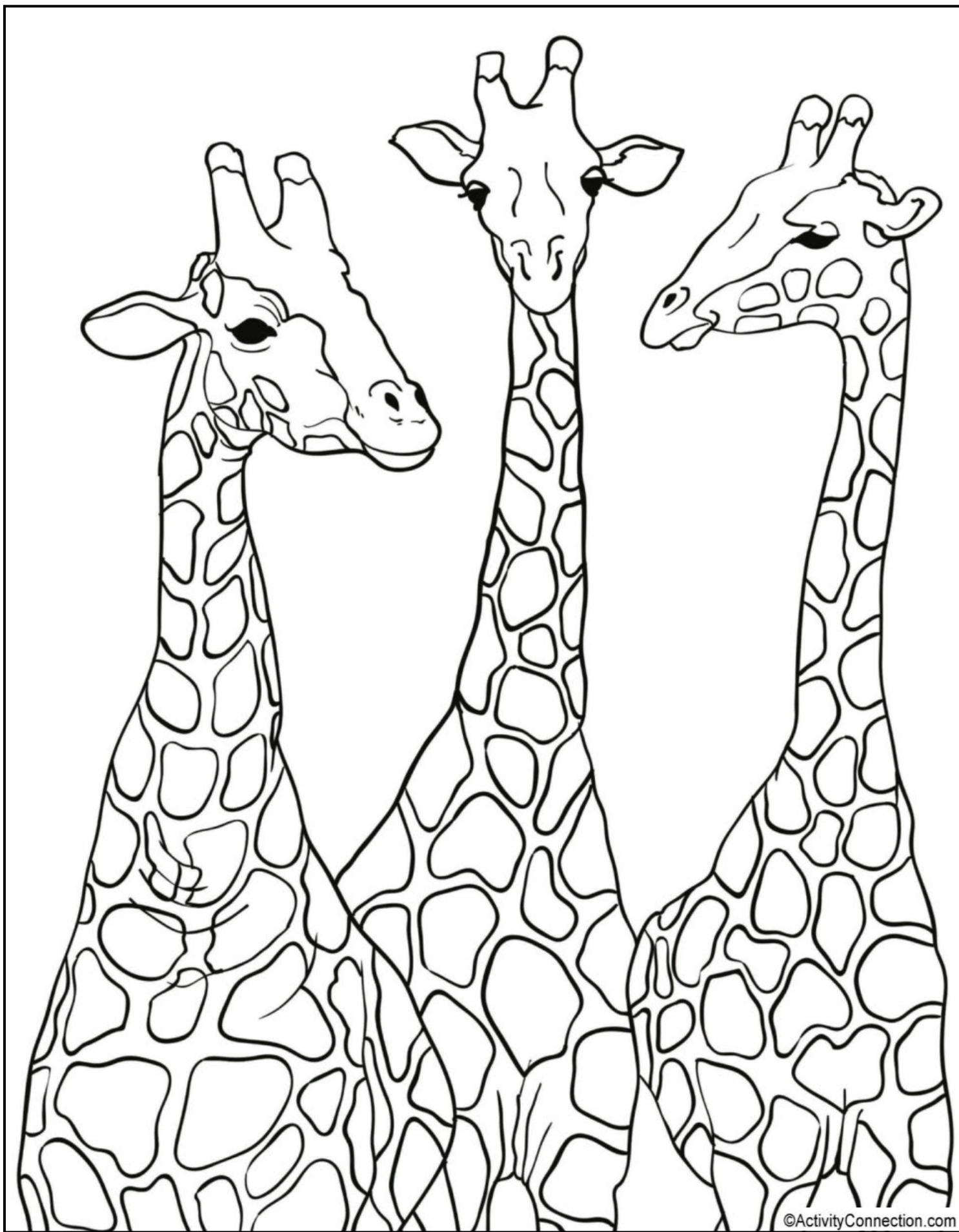
