It is time to get ready for Medicare Part D Open Enrollment

The 'Medicare' Annual Notice of Change will be coming to you via your mail box (snail mail). Please don't confuse it with all the 'junk' mail that comes your way!

Per www.medicareinteractive.org, —The Annual Notice of Change (ANOC) is a notice you receive from Medicare Advantage or Part D plan in late <u>September</u>. The ANOC gives a summary of any changes in the



plan's costs and coverage that will take effect January 1 of the next year. Review this notice to see if your plan will continue to meet your health care needs in the following year. If you do not receive an ANOC, you should contact your plan. The ANOC is typically mailed or emailed with the plan's Evidence of Coverage (EOC), which is a more comprehensive list of the plan's costs and benefits for the upcoming year. This is your first step to a successful Medicare Open Enrollment Period for 2024!

We are starting to gear up for the Part D enrollment season. More information will be in the September newsletter.








