### Possible actions:


- Choose a new Medicare Advantage Plan.

No paint or stains, chemicals, tires, pianos or organs, vanity tops and sinks, any furniture that is dirty or has torn fabric, old tube TVs, fluorescent light bulbs, encyclopedias, old text books, or mattresses and box springs.

Donations are accepted on Tuesdays from 12 pm - 4 pm and Thursdays from 8:30 am to 12 pm. One Saturday from 9 am to 1 pm is scheduled between each sale. To make a donation, pull up at the drive

through in front of building 6 and volunteers will come out and unload the car. They take the items into the building and start the sorting process. Each item is taken to the appropriate area. Volunteers then determine the value and price it. If you would like to help with this or would just like to see how it works stop in on any donation day, we will be happy to show you around.
