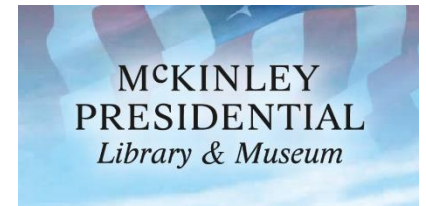


Ohio Celebrates America's 250th Birthday!!

Monday, July 13th

- 7:30 – 8:15 am Pickups will be in Celina, St Marys, and Wapakoneta. Exact pickup times will be determined approximately 30 days prior to trip departure.
- 11:00 am Lunch on your own at Beldon Village Mall food court.
- Noon Depart for the National First Ladies Museum Home, and "The Eras Exhibit: 250 Years of First Ladies Progress and Power," a special exhibit celebrating America's 250th birthday. This exhibit offers a fresh perspective on the lives and legacies of America's First Ladies, showcasing their profound impact on education, policy, and culture. The exhibit immerses visitors in American history, exploring the cultural influences that defined each era—from the Revolutionary War to the Modern Era. - 5:00 pm Depart for the Milana Ballroom at the Amish Door Restaurant for dinner and Salute to Old Glory Show by Vane Scott II. A plated meal along with party favors and birthday cake are included. - Balance due 5/29/26. Additional trip information and billing will be sent at that time.
- List of passenger names will be included in final billing.
- **Cancellation Policy - Deposit fully refundable up to 30 days prior to trip departure; 30-14 days prior to departure– 50% of your trip cost is non-refundable; 14 days prior to departure – 100% of trip cost is non-refundable. If replacement is found, you will be refunded all your money except for a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee.**
- If less than 30 passengers sign up for this trip, MCCOA reserves the right to cancel the trip or make any necessary changes to conduct the trip with a reduced number of passengers.
- Parking will be available in the parking lots at all locations. **Please plan to arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.**

- You may bring snacks and drinks on the bus.
