

MARNI'S FAVORITE RECIPES BAKED PUMPKIN SPICE DONUTS

This recipe for baked Pumpkin Spice Donuts has become a family favorite. I make them in mini donut size so they are the perfect appetizer (before or after dinner!). They are fun to make and they go quickly!

Serving: 12 regular donuts/36-48 mini donuts Recipe Credit: Samantha Merrit, Sugar Spun Run

Donut:

- 13/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 11/2 tsp baking powder
- 1/4 tsp baking soda
- 11/2 tsp pumpkin pie spice
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 3/4 cup pumpkin puree (not pie filling)
- 2 eggs
- 1/3 cup milk
- 11/2 tsp vanilla
- 3 tbsp butter (melted & cooled)

Glaze:

- 2 cups powdered sugar
- 1 tsp pumpkin pie spice
- 1/4 cup butter (melted)
- 1/2 tsp vanilla
- 2 tbsp water

Donut Baking Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350F, spray donut pan with non-stick baking spray
- 2. In a medium-sized bowl, whisk flour, sugars, baking powder, baking soda, pumpkin pie spice, cinnamon and salt together
- 3. In a separate bowl, whisk together pumpkin puree and melted butter
- 4. Add eggs, milk and vanilla and stir well
- 5. Combine dry and wet ingredients, fold carefully and do not over mix
- 6. Pour batter into a ziplock bag, cut the corner and use as a piping bag
- 7. Pipe batter into donut pans, fill each mold 2/3 full
- 8. Bake at 350F for 10-12 minutes (less for mini donuts)
- 9. Allow donuts to cool for 5-10 minutes in pan, allow to cool completely on rack before frosting

For Glaze:

- 1. In a small bowl, whisk together powdered sugar and pumpkin pie spice
- 2. Add butter, vanilla extract and water. Stir until combined
- 3. Dunk each donut into glaze and return to cooling rack. Allow glaze to harden



MARNI'S IDEAL DAY IN OGUNQUIT

If I had 24 hours in Ogunquit here is what I would do!

I have been coming to Ogunquit for many years and it has a very special place in my heart. While I have many versions of what I would call "my ideal day," here is just one example (though there are many more!). I thought it might give you some ideas as you plan your time in Ogunquit!

Morning (or night before.. I like to plan ahead!)

First, I look at the weather to see if it is going to be a stay-in kind of day or an outdoors day! If it's the latter, I love to spend as much time outside as possible - I check the tide chart so I can plan my time at the beach and go from there. I like to get out for a walk along the Marginal Way down to Ogunquit Main beach, stopping to get a "breakfast bowl" smoothie bowl at Loveshack. When I get to the beach, I'm always a little in awe of how stunning it is. When the tide is out, you can walk all the way down past Footbridge Beach to Wells and back with the beautiful rocky coast of Ogunquit ahead.

Afternoon

On the way back from the beach, even though it might not be 5 o'clock here yet, it's never too early to stop for a light lunch and margaritas with family at Bandito's (the frozen mango margaritas are the best). Then a leisurely walk back into town to stop at Ciao Candle Bar & Boutique (the smell from the candles always draws me in) and poke in some of the other shops along Shore Road.

Night

For dinner, we head down to Perkins Cove for dinner at Jackie's Too - if you time it right, you can get a table right next to the rocks overlooking the ocean. They have a great selection of seafood and other dishes, and the kids love it too! After dinner, we inevitably end up at Perkins Cove Candies for some chocolate and sweets. And then somehow, despite having had dessert already, we usually end up talking ourselves into making the walk back up Shore Road into town so we can cap the night off with ice cream at Big Daddy's (I personally like the Coffee Heath Bar frozen yogurt) and maybe shoot some hoops at the playground. Always so much to do!

I hope you enjoyed hearing a little bit about what one of my ideal days in Ogunquit might look like. Next time you come and stay with us, check out some of the places mentioned and see if they make your favorites list!


The suite was beautiful and clean. Shoutout to Barb, the property manager who made our stay as welcoming and hassle-free as possible.
