

### **Setting Tire Pressure**

One problem I have experienced over the years is setting the correct tire pressure. This is usually due to the tire pressure gauges I have had. The pencil gages which are cheap and, in most cases, free are practically useless. When setting the pressure using inadequate gages it rarely corresponds with the read outs from the tire sensors and you never seem to get the same reading twice. Recommended vehicle tire pressure is posted on the driver side door jam. Of course, you may want to adjust this according to weather conditions or your own preference.

Tire sensors are great for letting you know when you are losing air but give you an approximate figure for your actual tire pressure, at least in my opinion. If you have purchased a GM vehicle you get On-Star free for a period. OnStar gives you monthly reading regarding your percent of remaining oil life and tire pressure among other things. The readings from OnStar will correspond to the read out on your dash but rarely corresponds to actual to the actual pressure.

What this comes down to is getting a reliable tire pressure gauge. Larry Thomas had an article in the Cascade Corvette newsletter regarding this issue. He recommended the Vegagoo Pro Tire Pressure Gauge. This gauge keeps the reading even after removing it from the valve stem until you push the pressure release button. Another nice feature is that if you over inflate you can adjust to the exact pressure using the pressure release valve.

I usually keep on eye on tires to spot any decrease in tire pressure. However, with run flats this doesn't work and therefore the tire sensors give you the first clue if there is a problem. For regular tires with sensors the readout gives a warning if you are losing pressure. In my opinion these are the only advantages of the tire pressure sensors.

I purchased the Vegagoo Pressure Gauge and it works great. They are about \$11.00 from Amazon. I am sure there are other gauges equally as good.
