1000 HP Yenko/ SC Stage II Corvette

Twenty-five Yenko/ SC Corvettes will be available through Chevrolet dealers in 2019. The car will be either the Grand Sport coupe or convertible using a modified GM LT1 V8. In addition to the 1000 HP is produces 850 pounds feet of torque. In addition to the cost of a Grand Sport the Yenko package starts at \$68,995.00 or \$77,995.00 with 8 speed auto transmission. Opting for the Z07 performance package with carbon ceramic brakes is recommended.


HDCC Show and Shine 2018
