## Winterizing Your Corvette

Many of us put our Vettes away during the ice and snow months.

Lots of varied opinions on what to do to winterized your car. Here are a few ideas floating around.

- I. Install a battery tender to maintain a charge. Remember not all battery tenders are created equal. Spend a little more and get one that stops charging once the battery is to the appropriate level. A continuous charging can reduce your battery life.
- 2. Fill your tank with fuel to prevent condensation. Put fuel stabilizer in the tank. This is often debated as to the benefits but it is relatively cheap so why not.
- 3. Some place carpet or special foam pads under the tires to prevent flat spots. Others just turn the car around so the car is resting on a different location on the tire.. It is not recommended to jack your car up as this stresses the suspension and shocks.
  - 4. If possible start the car every week or so and get it up to temperature.
- 5. C7, Z51, Grand Sport, Z06 and ZR1 come standard with high performance/summer tires. Although not mentioned in the owners manual it is recommended not to expose these tires to sub freezing temperatures as it can cause damage to the tires.
- 6. Finally, if you drop some of your insurances coverages during the winter, be sure you reinstate the coverages when you begin driving the car. Verify that all coverages are reinstated.
