

World's Sixth Richest Man Drives a Corvette, Gets Pulled Over On His Own Island





Larry Ellison Net Worth 108 Billion Drives a Corvette

Owning the island still wasn't enough to keep billionaire Larry Ellison from getting a ticket for speeding in his <u>orange C8 Corvette convertible</u>, according to media reports.

The co-founder of Oracle and the world's sixth richest man with a Forbes-estimated net worth of \$108.3 billion, Ellison purchased some 98 percent of the properties on the Hawaiian island of Lanai for an estimated \$300 million in 2012 from fellow billionaire and Dole chairman David Murdock.

A blurred-out Ellison can be seen in the Corvette in bodycam footage obtained by Hawaii News Now explaining to an officer in October 2022 that he was just "trying to get home for dinner with my kids" when he ran a stop sign while speeding on Lanai near Manele Road. To his credit, though, Ellison didn't try to flaunt his wealth to get out of a ticket, telling the officer "there's no good excuse" for what he had done. "Okay, cool," the officer said. "Can I see your driver's license, registration, and insurance, please

Ellison looked through his belongings before finally having to tell the cop that he couldn't find his license. The Maui Police Department officer then issued a citation to Ellison.

It came with a host of upgrades including Chevy's legendary L-88 427 cubic-inch V8

The engine was officially rated at 430 hp but was actually far more powerful. Independent tests discovered its output was in the 560-580 hp range. It did not come with a radio, air conditioning or heater, which were all considered redundant to its focus on speed, but it still cost \$4,781, which was twice the base price of a standard Corvette Stingray.

Facts About the 2024 E-Ray

According to Chevrolet the E-Ray will be the fastest Corvette ever produced and the first Corvette designed for year round driving. It will go from 0 to 60 MPH in 2.5 seconds, and the quarter mile (1320 ft) in 10.5 seconds.

It is the only sports car with separate propulsion system, 6.2 L LT small block V8 495 HP and electric mode that gives 160 hp and 125 lb. ft torque to the front wheels for combined 655 Hp.

No need for plug in charging for the E-Ray battery system. The battery is charged via regenerative energy from coasting and braking, as well as normal driving.

STEATH Mode—All electric drive mode for street driving up to 45 MPH. NEW LIGHT WEIGHT lithium 12 volt battery. STANDARD BREMBO CERAMIC brake system STANDARD MAGNETIC ride control with 3 distinct settings TWENTY AND TWENTY-ONE inch wheels LOW WIDE STANCE with crafted body styling. 3.6 in wider that the standard Stingray. Same as Z07. THE AMOUNT OF ELECTIC ASSIST—is tailored to each of the six driving modes, i.e. tour, sprot, track, weather, My Mode and 2 Mode.

The E-Ray has two driver initiated modes 1. all electric and 2. gas and electric. The electric has maximum speed of 45 MPH. The V8 automatically engages once you pass 45 MPH.

Base Price for the Coupe is \$102,900.00 Convertible is \$115,840.00
