Guidelines

Thank you for volunteering to be our Club Photographer, or co-Photographer. You will play an important part in documenting club events and activities with your camera, whether it's your actual camera, or mobile phone camera.

These guidelines are just that, guidelines. Any, and all, modifications will be enhanced by your experience and techniques with photography. Please update these guidelines as you see fit.

Main events to be photographed:

- Club meetings where someone, or more than one person, is presented with a trophy, special gift, 50/50 winnings, etc.
- Social nights, if the opportunity presents itself.
- Corvette outings/events, ie. a local day drive, or to any Corvette-related event.
- Take pictures of club member(s) with their cars for the Website, sharing these with the Website coordinator.
- Annual Christmas party.
- HDCC Car Show at Bend Chevy, or specified location.
- End of Year Banquet.
- Biennial (every other year) COHD (Corvettes on the High Desert) fundraiser.
- COHD check presentation to the recipient of this fundraiser. (This happens asap after the Treasurer completes their accounting of this event.)

After taking pictures at any of the above occasions, edit your photographs, save them on a DVD, flash drive or your computer, and share them with the following individuals:

- Newsletter Editor
- Website coordinator
- Social Media coordinator

Encourage all club members to share their pictures with you, as well as the three individuals mentioned above.

At special events, ie. Christmas, it's always fun, and appreciated, to take pictures of each couple, a single, or even groups. These, especially, are beneficial for the Newsletter Editor when highlighting an event and the participants.

If, at any time, a club member requests a photograph of themselves, or one from a special event, you'll have the resources to accommodate them. There's no requirement for you to automatically send club members any pictures you have taken.

If you have any questions regarding being a Club Photographer, do not hesitate to ask any previous Club Photographer.

At the end of your term, or when you resign this volunteer position, please update these Guidelines and pass them to the current President by the February club meeting. He/She can update the Presidents Book before passing it along to the incoming President.
