Scholarship Program

Purpose: High Desert Corvette Club (HDCC) is offering two \$1,500.00 scholarships to graduating high school seniors, students currently enrolled in college or a trade school, or individuals who has left military service to continue their education in the field of auto technology.

Requirements:

1. Residence – The applicant’s primary residence must be in Deschutes, Jefferson, or Crook Counties.
2. Trade School – Any accredited automotive trade school is acceptable.
3. Scholastic—Before applying for the HDCC scholarship, the Applicant must meet the entrance requirements of the selected school.
4. Applicant’s Qualifying Activities – To include, but not limited to scholastic achievement, future goals, school activities, community activities, service to our country or communities, and application presentation.
5. Application – The applicant must complete and submit the entire application package before the April 10th deadline. The application must be complete, neat, and grammatically correct. The package must include:
 - a. The completed application form
 - b. Required financial information
 - c. Other financial aid awarded such as scholarships and grants
 - d. Personal statement
 - e. List of volunteer activities

- f. Certified transcripts from High School or College. A GPA of 2.75 or higher is desired.
- g. If the applicant has left the military a Form DD214 will be submitted in place of the school transcripts.
- h. Three letters of recommendation. If the applicant is a student, one must be a school counselor, teacher, or other faculty member.

Scholarship Committee –The committee will comprise three current HDCC members in good standing. The committee will meet and review the scholarship applications. Applicants who meet all requirements and receive approval from the committee will be scheduled for an interview. The committee will select finalists to be invited to the May business meeting. The members attending the May business meeting will vote for the applicants to award the scholarships. If the first choice(s) decides later not to go to post-secondary education, a selected alternate will be awarded the scholarship.

Award: The scholarship award will be sent directly to the college or trade school on behalf of the recipient. Funds must be used for books, tuition, and other curriculum expenses. If the scholarship recipient quits the program before the end of the funding period, the school will return any remaining unused portion to HDCC.
