Soap S.A.C.K. Information and Patterns

A Soap S.A.C.K. must be large enough to contain a new, full-size bar of soap in its original packaging, either plastic wrap or a box. It should measure about $4'' \times 5''$, and should have a drawstring or a loop to allow it to be hung on a hook, branch, etc. to dry. Preferably, it should be made from cotton yarn.

You may use any pretty color (not solid black or really dark brown) and any pattern and hook size that results in the proper dimensions.

We suggest you check your width after four or five rows; start over and adjust the number of stitches or hook size if your sack is too large or too small.
