

LOOMED SOAP SACKS

ON 12 PEG FLOWER LOOM

Use two strands of cotton yarn. Leave a 15" tail on the anchor peg.

E wrap Cast On (Wrap all 12 pegs going around the loom twice, take bottom loop & bring over top loop. This is your cast on row)

There are four options to choose from:

- #1 Entire sack is done with the e wrap stitch
- #2 One row e wrap, one row pearl
- #3 Three stitches e wrap, two stitches pearl
- #4 Tiny heart stitch (one row e wrap stitch, one row upside down pearl)

Choose one of the above options and knit for 5 inches. E wrap the last few rows to complete the length of the sack to 5 1/2 inches.

Cast off like a hat. Remove from loom & stretch to loosen stitches.

Use the 15" tail to go over & through & then over & through the top row of stitches. When the circle is complete, separate the two strands & crochet chain stitch each strand separately & tie together to make a loop. If you do not crochet just keep both strands together and use your needle to tie to the opening.
