HAT

Ribbing

With 16" (40.5 cm) circular needle, cast on 84{96} sts loosely (see Using Circular Needles, page 43); place a marker to indicate the beginning of the round (see Markers, page 42).

Rnds 1-12: ★ P2, K2; repeat from ★ around.

Body

Rnd 1 (Right side): Knit around.

Rnd 2: K1, P4, \star K2, P4; repeat from \star around to last st, K1.

Rnd 3: Knit around.

Rnd 4: P2, K2, \star P4, K2; repeat from \star around to last 2 sts, P2.

Repeat Rnds 1-4 for pattern until piece measures approximately 8" (20.5 cm) from cast on edge, ending by working Rnd 4.

SHAPING

Change to double-pointed needles when there are too few stitches to use a circular needle (see Using Double-Pointed Needles, page 43).

Rnd 1: \star K2 tog, K8, SSK; repeat from \star around: 70{80} sts.

Rnd 2: K1, P3, \star K2, P3; repeat from \star around to last st, K1.

Rnd 3: Knit around.

Rnd 4: ★ K2 tog, K1, P4, K1, SSK; repeat from ★ around: 56[64] sts.

Rnd 5: Knit around.

Rnd 6: K1, P2, \star K2, P2; repeat from \star around to last st, K1.

Rnd 7: \star K2 tog, K4, SSK; repeat from \star around: 42{48} sts.

Rnd 8: K1, P4, \star K2, P4; repeat from \star around to last st, K1.

Rnd 9: \star K2 tog, K2, SSK; repeat from \star around: 28{32} sts.

Rnd 10: Knit around.

Rnd 11: \star K2 tog, SSK; repeat from \star around: 14{16} sts.

Rnd 12: K2 tog around: 7{8} sts.

Cut yarn leaving an 8" (20.5 cm) length for sewing. Thread yarn needle with end

and slip remaining sts onto yarn needle; pull **tightly** to close and secure end.

FINGERLESS MITT

(Make 2)

Cuff

With double-pointed needles, cast on 36{40} sts loosely.

Divide sts evenly onto 4 needles; place a split-ring marker around the first stitch to indicate the beginning of the round.

Rnds 1 thru $10{9}$: \star P2, K2; repeat from \star around.

Size Large - Rnd 10: Work in K2, P2 ribbing around working M1 twice evenly spaced: 42 sts.



Body

Rnd 1 (Right side): Knit around.

Rnd 2: K1, P4, \star K2, P4; repeat from \star around to last st. K1.

Rnd 3: Knit around.

Rnd 4: P2, K2, \star P4, K2; repeat from \star around to last 2 sts, P2.

Repeat Rnds 1-4 for pattern until piece measures approximately 5" (12.5 cm) from cast on edge, ending by working Rnd 4.

GUSSET

Rnd 1: Knit around, place a marker around the right needle, M1: 37{43} sts.

Rnd 2: K1, P4, \star K2, P4; repeat from \star around to within one st of marker, K1, slip marker, K1.

Rnd 3: Knit around to marker, slip marker, M1, K1, M1: 39{45} sts.

Rnd 4: P2, K2, ★ P4, K2; repeat from ★ around to within 2 sts of marker, P2, slip marker, K3.

Rnd 5: Knit around to marker, slip marker, M1, K3, M1: 41{47} sts. Rnd 6: K1, P4, \star K2, P4; repeat from \star around to within one st of marker, K1, slip marker, K5.

Rnd 7: Knit around to marker, slip marker, M1, K5, M1: 43{49} sts.

Rnd 8: P2, K2, ★ P4, K2; repeat from ★ around to within 2 sts of marker, P2, slip marker, K7.

Rnd 9: Knit around to marker, slip marker, M1, K7, M1: 45{51} sts.

Rnd 10: K1, P4, ★ K2, P4; repeat from ★ around to within one st of marker, K1, slip marker, K9.

HAND

Rnd 1: Knit around to marker, remove marker, place next 9 sts onto st holder: 36{42} sts.

Rnd 2: P2, K2, \star P4, K2; repeat from \star around to last 2 sts, P2.

Rnd 3: Knit around.

Rnd 4: K1, P4, \star K2, P4; repeat from \star around to last st, K1.

Rnd 5: Knit around.

Rnd 6: P2, K2, \star P4, K2; repeat from \star around to last 2 sts, P2.

Ribbing

Rnds 1-6: ★ P2, K2; repeat from ★ around.

Bind off all sts loosely in ribbing.

Thumb

Place sts from st holder onto 2 double-pointed needles as follows: Place 5 sts onto Needle 1 and 4 sts onto Needle 2. With Needle 3, pick up 3 sts in the gap where the thumb meets the hand (Fig. 9, page 45); place a split-ring marker around the first stitch to indicate the beginning of the round: 12 sts.

Redistribute sts to have 4 sts on each needle.

Rnds 1-3: Knit around.

Rnds 4-7: ★ P2, K2; repeat from ★ around.

Bind off all sts loosely in ribbing.
